Acts of the Apostles 2,1-21

When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. And suddenly from heaven there came a sound like the rush of a violent wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting. Divided tongues, as of fire, appeared among them, and a tongue rested on each of them. All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages, as the Spirit gave them ability. Now there were devout Jews from every nation under heaven living in Jerusalem. And at this sound the crowd gathered and was bewildered, because each one heard them speaking in the native language of each. Amazed and astonished, they asked, 'Are not all these who are speaking Galileans? And how is it that we hear, each of us, in our own native language? Parthians, Medes, Elamites, and residents of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya belonging to Cyrene, and visitors from Rome, both Jews and proselytes, Cretans and Arabs in our own languages we hear them speaking about God's deeds of power.' All were amazed and perplexed, saying to one another, 'What does this mean?' But others sneered and said, 'They are filled with new wine.' But Peter, standing with the eleven, raised his voice and addressed them: 'Men of Judea and all who live in Jerusalem, let this be known to you, and listen to what I say. Indeed, these are not drunk, as you suppose, for it is only nine o'clock in the morning. No, this is what was spoken through the prophet Joel: "In the last days it will be, God declares, that I will pour out my Spirit upon all flesh, and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams. Even upon my slaves, both men and women, in those days I will pour out my Spirit; and they shall prophesy. And I will show portents in the heaven above and signs on the earth below, blood, and fire, and smoky mist. The sun shall be turned to darkness and the moon to blood, before the coming of the Lord's great and glorious day. Then everyone who calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved."

GOSPEL READING - Saint John 14,15-20.

'If you love me, you will keep my commandments. And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate, to be with you for ever. This is the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him, because he abides with you, and he will be in you. 'I will not leave you orphaned; I am coming to you. In a little while the world will no longer see me, but you will see me; because I live, you also will live. On that day you will know that I am in my Father, and you in me, and I in you.

سفر أعمال الرسل 1:2-21

يا إخوتي، في تمام اليوم الخمسين، كان الرسل معاً في مكان واحد. فحدثت بغتة دوي من السماء كأنه دوي ريح عاصفة، وملاً كل البيت حيث كانوا جالسين. وظهرت لهم السنة منقسمة كأنها من نار، واستقر على كل واحد منهم لسان. وامتأوا كلهم من الروح القدس، وبدأوا يتكلمون بالسنة أحرى، كما كان الروح يؤتيتهم أن ينطقوا. وكان يقيم في أورشليم يهود، رجال أنقياء من كل أمة تحت السماء. فلما حدث ذلك الصوت، احتشد الجمع وأخذتهم الحيرة، لأن كل واحد منهم كان يسمعهم يتكلمون بلغته. فدهشوا وتعجبوا وقالوا: «أليس هؤلاء المتكلمون جميعهم جليليين؟ فكيف يسمعهم كل واحد منا باللغة التي ولد فيها؟ ونحن فرثيون، وماديون، وعيلاميون، وسكان ما بين النهرين، واليهودية، وكبدوكية، وبنطس، وآسيا، وفريجية، وبمفيلية، ومصر، ونواحي ليبيا القريية من قبروان، ورومانيون نرلاء، يهود ومهندون، وكريتيون، وعرب، نسمعهم يتكلمون بالسنتنا عن أعمال الله العظيمة.» وكانوا كلهم مدهوشين حارين يقول بعضهم لبعض: «ما معنى هذا؟» «لكن آخرين كانوا يقولون ساخرين: «إنهم قد امتأوا سلافة!» «فوقف بطرس مع الأحد عشر، ورفع صوته وخطبهم قائلاً: «أيها الرجال اليهود، ويا جميع المقيمين في أورشليم، ليكن هذا معلوماً عنكم، وأصعوا إلى كلامي. لا، ليس هؤلاء بسكارى، كما تظنون. فالساعة هي التاسعة صباحاً. بل هذا هو ما قيل بيوبيل النبي: ويكون في الأيام الأخيرة، يقول الله، أنني أفيض من روجي على كل بشر، فيتنبأ بنوكم وبناتكم، ويرى شبانكم رؤى، ويحلم شيوخكم أحلاماً. وعلى عبيدي وإمائي أيضاً أفيض من روجي في تلك الأيام فيتنبأون. وأعمل عجائب في السماء من فوق، وآيات على الأرض من أسفل، دماً وناراً وأعمدة من دخان. وتقلب الشمس ظلاماً والقمر دماً قبل أن يأتي يوم الرب، اليوم العظيم المجيد. فيكون أن كل من يدعو باسم الرب يخلص.»

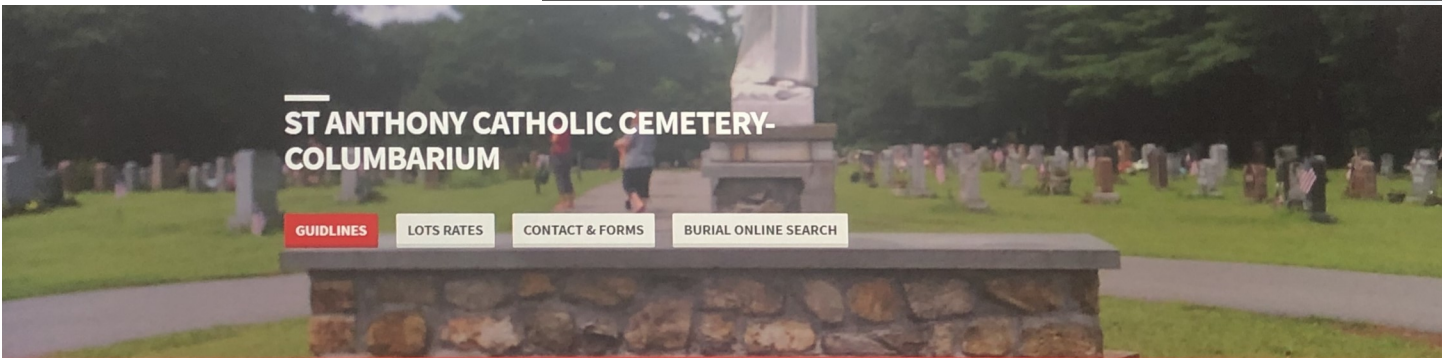

MESSAGE FROM PARISH COUNCIL



Saint Anthony's Church is excited to announce a significant upgrade to our cemetery software. It is unique and considerably superior with features such as digital record keeping and GPS mapping. It is so innovative it can be accessed easily from any device and provide walking or driving directions directly to your grave site. The software is completely secure with records backed-up numerous times throughout the day. No more pulling the paper file from the file cabinet anymore. Our deceased loved ones will be forever in our Parish records. Each family will be able to accurately maintain, update, and submit records and information of their loved ones. You can send the obituary notice, special documents, letters, receipts etc. to rectory@stanthonylawrence.org in a pdf or jpg format and we will attach that to your loved ones record. Please make sure all emails are accurately and clearly labeled so we attach them to the correct parishioner. Attaching documents is entirely at your discretion.

In order to make this successful and achieve its full benefit we have to rely on each parishioner to update their loved ones records as best as they can.

The following steps will help you access the tool:

1. Scroll to the bottom and click on BURIAL ONLINE SEARCH
2. Type in the last name and first name or in some cases just last name and click search
3. Click on the name
4. In the middle of the page, look for "Do you know more about this person or their ancestors"? Click here.
5. You can then complete any or all the fields and click submit.

Once you complete the above, all data will be sent back to Saint Anthony's Rectory and will be uploaded and saved.

Another incredible feature is click on view Saint Anthony's Maronite Map or locate on map. It will take you to a Google Earth view of the cemetery with your grave site showing. Move your wheel on the mouse or zoom in and you will see the individual burial plots. You can click on drive or walk and it defaults to Google Maps and provides directions right to your grave site from wherever you are.

We highly encourage everyone to take advantage of this software. We can make this successful and achieve our goal of remembering every loved one in our Saint Anthony's Parish family for generations to come.

Liturgy Attendance Requirements

- **FACE MASKS ARE REQUIRED** prior to your entering the church building. No one (over the age of 5) is allowed in the building without a mask
- Be mindful of everyone's health and safety by practicing a non-contact and non-touch experience. We must greet others in a no-contact way. Please avoid hand-shaking, hugs and kisses, and always maintain a six-foot distance from others during the entire time.
- The sign of the peace will be without contact throughout the church.
- Communion will be given in the "HAND" only. You **MUST** wear your face mask to receive communion. This is for the safety of the clergy and yourself. **AFTER** you receive communion in your hand, you may take off your face mask/covering to place communion in your mouth then immediately put it back.
