



Deacon Michael Marie Joseph Charchaflian



Born in Damascus Syria on July 4, 1958, from Armenian Father, Joseph, and Syriac-Armenian Mother, Virginie. He is the oldest of five children, Clara, Rita, and Pierre and Paul. He attended the Armenian Sister Academy, Lazarists' Fathers, Marist's Friars, and graduated High School from the Lycée Français. His family immigrated to Lebanon and later to Argentina. At the age of 19 he came to the US as a student and graduated from the University of Lowell in Electrical and Computer Engineering, class of 1983. He pursued his master's degree at Worcester Polytechnic Institute and for 5 years he worked as a Filed Problem-Solving Engineer for Digital Equipment Corporation. Later he founded and managed, for 18 years, Automation & Information Planners, a Technology and Strategy Consulting Firm. Deacon Michael was married and has a son, Hovig (33), and a daughter, Kenar (28); his marriage was annulled by the Catholic church.

In 2005 he served with the American Red Cross, as a member of the Disaster Relief Team, during the Louisiana Hurricanes, Katrina & Rita. From this human and spiritual experience stemmed his calling to serve the church. He attended St. John Seminary if the Archdiocese of Boston Diaconate Formation, class of 2008. He was ordained deacon in the Armenian Church on Corpus Christy in 2015. He later continued his studies at St. Charles Borromeo Seminary in Philadelphia and for his master's in pastoral theology at the Pontifical College Josephinum of Columbus, Ohio.

For the past 10 years Deacon Michael worked as a Prison Chaplain at the Billerica House of Correction. For the past 4 years he assisted at St. Anthony's Maronite Catholic Church in Lawrence, Massachusetts, at the request of its pastor, Fr. Elie Mikhael. In 2020 Bishop Gregory Mansour incardinated Deacon Michael into the Eparchy of St. Maron of Brooklyn. He continued to serve at St.

Anthony's until his recent six-month ----- assignment at St. Sharbel's in Somerset, New Jersey.

As of November 1, 2021, Bishop Gregory appointed Deacon Michael at St. Anthony's in Lawrence, Massachusetts, where he will continue for his priestly formation.

CEMETERY RULES & GUIDELINES

Several inquiries have been made regarding Cemetery flowers and plants at the graves. In order for us to maintain a respectable resting place for our loved ones, guidelines are set in place and available on our website for your reference.

Planting Policy

The planting policy of St. Anthony Maronite Cemetery is as follows. Flowers only (either annuals or perennials) may be planted at the base of a monument with the following stipulations:

- 1. The flowerbed may be no wider than the width of the monument base and must come out from the monument base no more than eight (8) inches.
- **2**.No shrubs, trees, or bushes may be planted in the planting bed.
- 3. Ornaments, such as plastic decorations, pinwheels, animal figurines, balloons, etc. are not allowed.
- 4.No bed covering, such as mulch or stones, etc. may be added to the planting bed.
- 5. Upkeep of the planted materials is the sole responsibility of the person who has planted the flowers.
- 6.St. Anthony Cemetery bears no responsibility for upkeep nor does it assume liability for damage, theft, or vandalism with regard to the plantings or the planting bed.
- 7.If plantings and planting bed are not maintained, or if inappropriate materials appear in the bed, St. Anthony Cemetery reserves the right to remove any dead plants or inappropriate materials.
- 8.On occasion, the cemetery maintenance staff may remove plantings to accommodate a burial or other activity. Cemetery staff cannot replace plantings.

Note that plantings cannot be placed on a Flat Marker Lot, but only on an upright Monument Lot.

EPISTLES FOR THIS WEEKEND

Galatians 4:21-31 - 5:1

Brothers and sisters, Tell me, you who desire to be subject to the law, will you not listen to the law? For it is written that Abraham had two sons, one by a slave woman and the other by a free woman. One, the child of the slave, was born according to the flesh; the other, the child of the free woman, was born through the promise. Now this is an allegory: these women are two covenants. One woman, in fact, is Hagar, from Mount Sinai, bearing children for slavery. Now Hagar is Mount Sinai in Arabia and corresponds to the present Jerusalem, for she is in slavery with her children. But the other woman corresponds to the Jerusalem above; she is free, and she is our mother. For it is written, 'Rejoice, you childless one, you who bear no children, burst into song and shout, you who endure no birth pangs; for the children of the desolate woman are more numerous than the children of the one who is married.' Now you, my friends, are children of the promise, like Isaac. But just as at that time the child who was born according to the flesh persecuted the child who was born according to the Spirit, so it is now also. But what does the scripture say? 'Drive out the slave and her child; for the child of the slave will not share the inheritance with the child of the free woman.' So then, friends, we are children, not of the slave but of the free woman. For freedom Christ has set us free. Stand firm, therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery.

Luke 1:57-66

Now the time came for Elizabeth to give birth, and she bore a son. Her neighbours and relatives heard that the Lord had shown his great mercy to her, and they rejoiced with her. On the eighth day they came to circumcise the child, and they were going to name him Zechariah after his father. But his mother said, 'No; he is to be called John.' They said to her, 'None of your relatives has this name.' Then they began motioning to his father to find out what name he wanted to give him. He asked for a writing-tablet and wrote, 'His name is John.' And all of them were amazed. Immediately his mouth was opened and his tongue freed, and he began to speak, praising God. Fear came over all their neighbours, and all these things were talked about throughout the entire hill country of Judea. All who heard them pondered them and said, 'What then will this child become?' For, indeed, the hand of the Lord was with him.


