"The Holy Rosary: A Path to Christ "

Dear Parishioners,

The Rosary is one of the most powerful prayers in the Catholic tradition, a spiritual tool that invites us to meditate on the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ through the loving eyes of His Blessed Mother. It is much more than a repetition of prayers; it is a journey into the mysteries of our salvation, drawing us closer to Jesus through Mary.

Saint John Paul II called the Rosary "a prayer both so simple and so profound." He taught that through the Rosary, "the faithful receive abundant grace, as though from the very hands of the Mother of the Redeemer." This prayer, often referred to as the "weapon" against evil, is a direct line to Mary, who intercedes for us before her Son. With each bead, we are reminded of her maternal care and her desire to lead us to Jesus.

Saint Louis de Montfort, one of the greatest advocates of the Rosary, expressed its power with these words: "The Rosary is the most powerful weapon to touch the Heart of Jesus, our Redeemer, who loves His Mother." Through it, we reflect on the mysteries of Christ's life—the joyful, sorrowful, luminous, and glorious moments that have shaped our faith. In praying the Rosary, we enter more deeply into these mysteries, allowing them to transform our hearts.

Saint Padre Pio also urged the faithful to pray the Rosary, often saying, "The Rosary is the weapon for these times." He knew that in a world filled with challenges and trials, the Rosary offers peace, hope, and protection. It brings us back to the essentials of our faith, grounding us in Christ's love and the example of Mary's perfect discipleship.

In each mystery of the Rosary, we encounter moments of grace. As we meditate on the Annunciation, we are reminded of Mary's "yes" to God's plan, inspiring us to say "yes" to His will in our own lives. In the Passion of Christ, we are drawn into His sacrificial love, which strengthens us to carry our own crosses. And in the Glorious Resurrection, we are filled with the hope of eternal life, knowing that Jesus has conquered death.

As Saint Dominic, to whom Mary entrusted the Rosary, said, "One day, through the Rosary and the Scapular, Our Lady will save the world." The Rosary is a gift from heaven, a way to remain close to Jesus and Mary in all the circumstances of our lives.

Praying the Rosary allows us to ponder the mysteries of Christ with Mary and receive the strength, peace, and grace we need to live out our faith. Let us take up the Rosary daily, trusting in its transformative power and in Mary's loving intercession.





Fourth Sunday of The Cross: Faithful and Wise Slave

Book of Genesis 41: 38-44

Pharaoh said to his servants, 'Can we find anyone else like this one in whom is the spirit of God?' So Pharaoh said to Joseph, 'Since God has shown you all this, there is no one so discerning and wise as you. You shall be over my house, and all my people shall order themselves as you command; only with regard to the throne will I be greater than you.' And Pharaoh said to Joseph, 'See, I have set you over all the land of Egypt.' Removing his signet ring from his hand, Pharaoh put it on Joseph's hand; he arrayed him in garments of fine linen, and put a gold chain around his neck. He had him ride in the chariot of his second-in-command; and they cried out in front of him, 'Bow the knee!' Thus he set him over all the land of Egypt. Moreover, Pharaoh said to Joseph, 'I am Pharaoh, and without your consent no one shall lift up hand or foot in all the land of Egypt.'

First Letter to the Thessalonians 5: 1-11

Concerning the times and the seasons, brothers and sisters, you do not need to have anything written to you. For you yourselves know very well that the day of the Lord will come like a thief in the night. When they say, 'There is peace and security', then sudden destruction will come upon them, as labour pains come upon a pregnant woman, and there will be no escape! But you, beloved, are not in darkness, for that day to surprise you like a thief; for you are all children of light and children of the day; we are not of the night or of darkness. So then, let us not fall asleep as others do, but let us keep awake and be sober; for those who sleep sleep at night, and those who are drunk get drunk at night. But since we belong to the day, let us be sober, and put on the breastplate of faith and love, and for a helmet the hope of salvation. For God has destined us not for wrath but for obtaining salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ, who died for us, so that whether we are awake or asleep we may live with him. Therefore encourage one another and build up each other, as indeed you are doing.

Holy Gospel of Jesus Christ according to Saint Matthew 24: 45-51

'Who then is the faithful and wise slave, whom his master has put in charge of his household, to give the other slaves their allowance of food at the proper time? Blessed is that slave whom his master will find at work when he arrives. Truly I tell you, he will put that one in charge of all his possessions. But if that wicked slave says to himself, "My master is delayed", and he begins to beat his fellow-slaves, and eats and drinks with drunkards, the master of that slave will come on a day when he does not expect him and at an hour that he does not know. He will cut him in pieces and put him with the hypocrites, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.
