

Why should I go to Confession?

Dear Parishioners,

On the Sunday of the Hemorrhaging woman, we see a weak person ashamed of her condition, marginalized by society, who, despite everything, comes to Jesus to confess her weakness. I would like to reflect on The Sacrament of Reconciliation, often referred to as Confession, which is a profound gift from God that plays a vital role in our spiritual journey.

It is a sacrament of healing, mercy, and renewal, where we encounter the boundless love of Christ, who forgives our sins and restores us to grace. Yet, despite its importance, many people avoid this sacrament, often using pretexts such as, "I confess directly to God," or "Who is the priest to forgive my sins?" and others. These objections, while understandable, overlook the divine institution and spiritual power of Confession.

First, it is true that we can and should confess our sins directly to God in prayer. However, the Sacrament of Reconciliation is not merely a human invention, it was established by Christ Himself. In John 20:22-23, Jesus breathes on His disciples and says, "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained." Through this act, Jesus entrusted the authority to forgive sins to His Church, making the priest an instrument of His mercy. As Saint Augustine teaches, "The Church forgives sins through the ministry of priests, not because they are worthy, but because Christ works through them."

Another common objection is, "Who is the priest to judge me?" It's important to remember that the priest is not there to judge but to act as a mediator of God's mercy offering absolution and guidance. Saint John Vianney, the patron saint of priests, once said, "The priest is not his own; he belongs to God. He is a channel of grace, a bridge between heaven and earth." The priest's role is to help us confront our sins with honesty and to lead us toward spiritual growth.

Some also avoid Confession out of fear or shame, believing their sins are too great to be forgiven. But the saints remind us that no sin is beyond God's mercy. Saint Faustina Kowalska wrote, "The greater the sinner, the greater the right they have to My mercy." Confession is not a place of condemnation but a place of healing, where we experience the liberating power of God's love.

Ultimately, the Sacrament of Reconciliation is essential for our spiritual journey because it restores our relationship with God and the Church. It humbles us, strengthens us, and helps us grow in holiness. As Saint Josemaría Escrivá said, "Confession is the sacrament of joy, the sacrament of the return to the Father's house."

Let us not allow fear, pride, or excuses to keep us from this incredible gift of grace. Instead, let us approach the confessional with trust, knowing that God's mercy is waiting to transform our hearts, and heal our souls.

Third Sunday of Great Lent: Healing of the Hemorrhaging Woman

Book of Numbers 15:37-41

The LORD said to Moses: Speak to the Israelites, and tell them to make fringes on the corners of their garments throughout their generations and to put a blue cord on the fringe at each corner. You have the fringe so that, when you see it, you will remember all the commandments of the LORD and do them, and not follow the lust of your own heart and your own eyes. So you shall remember and do all my commandments, and you shall be holy to your God. I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: I am the LORD your God.

Second Letter to the Corinthians 7:4-11

I often boast about you; I have great pride in you; I am filled with consolation; I am overjoyed in all our affliction. For even when we came into Macedonia, our bodies had no rest, but we were afflicted in every way disputes without and fears within. But God, who consoles the downcast, consoled us by the arrival of Titus, and not only by his coming, but also by the consolation with which he was consoled about you, as he told us of your longing, your mourning, your zeal for me, so that I rejoiced still more. For even if I made you sorry with my letter, I do not regret it though I did regret it, for I see that I grieved you with that letter, though only briefly. Now I rejoice, not because you were grieved, but because your grief led to repentance; for you felt a godly grief, so that you were not harmed in any way by us. For godly grief produces a repentance that leads to salvation and brings no regret, but worldly grief produces death. For see what earnestness this godly grief has produced in you, what eagerness to clear yourselves, what indignation, what alarm, what longing, what zeal, what punishment! At every point you have proved yourselves guiltless in the matter.

Holy Gospel of Jesus Christ according to Saint Luke 8:40-56

When Jesus returned, the crowd welcomed him, for they were all waiting for him. Just then there came a man named Jairus, a leader of the synagogue. He fell at Jesus' feet and begged him to come to his house, for he had an only daughter, about twelve years old, who was dying. As he went, the crowds pressed in on him. Now there was a woman who had been suffering from haemorrhages for twelve years; and though she had spent all she had on physicians, no one could cure her. She came up behind him and touched the fringe of his clothes, and immediately her haemorrhage stopped. Then Jesus asked, 'Who touched me?' When all denied it, Peter said, 'Master, the crowds surround you and press in on you.' But Jesus said, 'Someone touched me; for I noticed that power had gone out from me.' When the woman saw that she could not remain hidden, she came trembling; and falling down before him, she declared in the presence of all the people why she had touched him, and how she had been immediately healed. He said to her, 'Daughter, your faith has made you well; go in peace.' While he was still speaking, someone came from the leader's house to say, 'Your daughter is dead; do not trouble the teacher any longer.' When Jesus heard this, he replied, 'Do not fear. Only believe, and she will be saved.' When he came to the house, he did not allow anyone to enter with him, except Peter, John, and James, and the child's father and mother. They were all weeping and wailing for her; but he said, 'Do not weep; for she is not dead but sleeping.' And they laughed at him, knowing that she was dead. But he took her by the hand and called out, 'Child, get up!' Her spirit returned, and she got up at once. Then he directed them to give her something to eat. Her parents were astounded; but he ordered them to tell no one what had happened

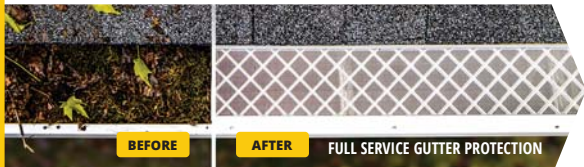
