Dear Parishioners,

"Blessed are those who die in the Lord... they will rest from their labors, for their deeds follow them."—Revelation 14:13

With heavy hearts, we reflect on the passing of Pope Francis, a shepherd of profound humility, compassion, and unwavering faith. Born Jorge Mario Bergoglio in Buenos Aires, Argentina, he lived a life dedicated to serving Christ and His Church—first as a Jesuit priest, then as Archbishop of Buenos Aires, and finally as the 266th Successor of St. Peter.

Pope Francis' pontificate was marked by his deep concern for the poor, his call for mercy and reconciliation, and his efforts to bring the Church into dialogue with the modern world. From his encyclicals on care for creation (Laudato Si') and fraternal love (Fratelli Tutti), to his pastoral outreach to refugees, prisoners, and the marginalized, he embodied the Gospel message of love in action. His simplicity—eschewing grandeur for a humble lifestyle—challenged us all to live more authentically as disciples of Christ.

As we mourn his passing, we also give thanks for his spiritual leadership, his prophetic voice, and his reminder that "God never tires of forgiving us; it is we who tire of asking for mercy."

In the coming days, the College of Cardinals will gather in Rome for the conclave—the sacred process of electing a new pope. Guided by the Holy Spirit, they will deliberate in prayer and discernment until a successor is chosen. The new pope will inherit the mantle of St. Peter at a pivotal time for the Church and the world.

Let us pray:

For the soul of Pope Francis, that he may rest in the peace of Christ.

For the Cardinals, that they may be wise and open to the Spirit's guidance.

For the Church, that we may remain united in faith, hope, and love during this transition.

"The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want." — Psalm 23:1 May we honor Pope Francis' legacy by living the Gospel with joy, mercy, and courage.

#### Second Sunday of the Resurrection: New Sunday

#### Book of Isaiah 52:7-12

How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of the messenger who announces peace, who brings good news, who announces salvation, who says to Zion, 'Your God reigns.' Listen! Your sentinels lift up their voices, together they sing for joy; for in plain sight they see the return of the LORD to Zion. Break forth together into singing, you ruins of Jerusalem; for the LORD has comforted his people, he has redeemed Jerusalem. The LORD has bared his holy arm before the eyes of all the nations; and all the ends of the earth shall see the salvation of our God. Depart, depart, go out from there! Touch no unclean thing; go out from the midst of it, purify yourselves, you who carry the vessels of the LORD. For you shall not go out in haste, and you shall not go in flight; for the LORD will go before you, and the God of Israel will be your rearguard .

#### Second Letter to the Corinthians 5,11-21

Therefore, knowing the fear of the Lord, we try to persuade others; but we ourselves are well known to God, and I hope that we are also well known to your consciences. We are not commending ourselves to you again, but giving you an opportunity to boast about us, so that you may be able to answer those who boast in outward appearance and not in the heart. For if we are beside ourselves, it is for God; if we are in our right mind, it is for you. For the love of Christ urges us on, because we are convinced that one has died for all; therefore all have died. And he died for all, so that those who live might live no longer for themselves, but for him who died and was raised for them. From now on, therefore, we regard no one from a human point of view; even though we once knew Christ from a human point of view, we know him no longer in that way. So if anyone is in Christ, there is a new creation: everything old has passed away; see, everything has become new! All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation; that is, in Christ God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting the message of reconciliation to us. So we are ambassadors for Christ, since God is making his appeal through us; we entreat you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God. For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God .

#### Holy Gospel of Jesus Christ according to Saint John 20,26-31

A week later his disciples were again in the house, and Thomas was with them. Although the doors were shut, Jesus came and stood among them and said, 'Peace be with you.' Then he said to Thomas, 'Put your finger here and see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it in my side. Do not doubt but believe.' Thomas answered him, 'My Lord and my God!' Jesus said to him, 'Have you believed because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have come to believe.' Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of his disciples, which are not written in this book. But these are written so that you may come to believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that through believing you may have life in his name .


