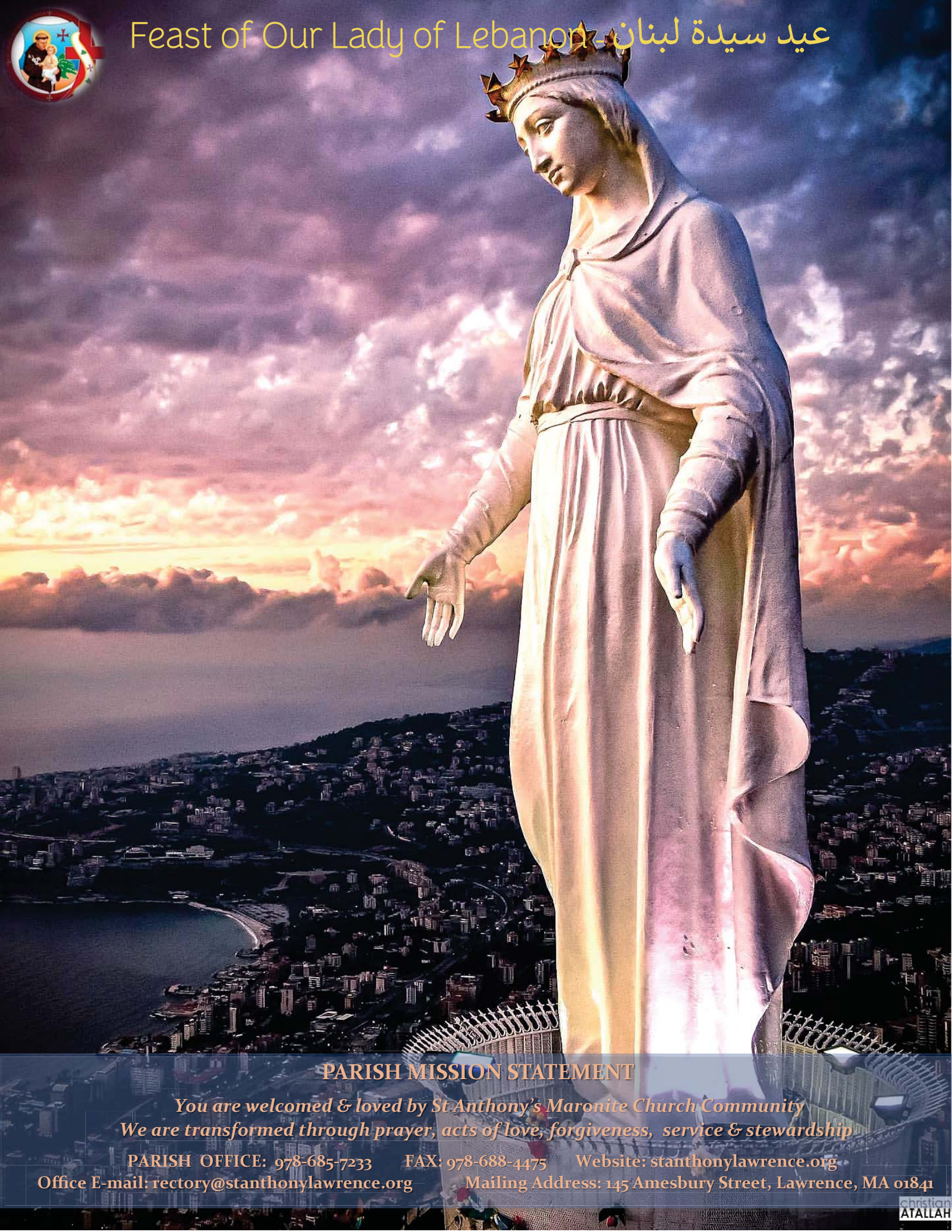

Dear Parishioners,

The month of May is a time of grace, a time set aside by the Church to honor the Blessed Virgin Mary in a special way. This year, the month carries an even deeper meaning: we mourn the loss of Pope Francis, a humble shepherd who loved Mary deeply and entrusted the Church to her maternal care. As the Church enters a period of transition and prepares for the election of a new pope, our hearts turn naturally to the Virgin Mary, our Mother, our Advocate, and our model of trust in God's providence.

That is why as we start the month of May; I want to meditate on Mary through the eyes of Pope Francis.

From the earliest days of his pontificate, Pope Francis has emphasized Mary's closeness to humanity. "She is a mother who helps us to grow, to face life, and to be free," he said during a homily on the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God (Homily, January 1, 2018). Her motherhood is not limited to Jesus alone, but extends to all of us. She watches over us with tenderness, especially in times of difficulty, offering comfort, protection, and hope.

For Pope Francis, Mary is the first disciple, the one who responded to God's call with trust and surrender. "Mary is the woman of faith, the woman of prayer, the woman of courage," he said (General Audience, October 23, 2013). Her "yes" at the Annunciation (Lk 1:38) becomes a lifelong witness of obedience and mission. She teaches us how to say "yes" to God in our daily lives, even when His plans are mysterious or challenging.

The Pope also sees in Mary a source of unity for the Church. As Mother of the Church, she gathers us as a people, never allowing us to be orphans. In his Apostolic Exhortation *Evangelii Gaudium*, he writes: "With the Holy Spirit, Mary is always present in the midst of the people... she joins us in our struggles and she constantly surrounds us with God's love" (§284). Her intercession is powerful because she is close to both her Son and to us.

Pope Francis often urges us to take refuge under Mary's mantle, especially through the Rosary, which he calls "a prayer that always accompanies me; it is also the prayer of the ordinary people and the saints" (Interview, October 2013). In Mary, he sees not only a spiritual guide, but a real companion on the journey of faith.

To love Mary, in the eyes of Pope Francis, is to love Jesus more deeply, to walk in trust, and to live with the joy of the Gospel.

Let us open our hearts this May to her example of faith and courage, and let us entrust the Church to her intercession, praying that the Holy Spirit may guide the College of Cardinals to choose a new pope after the heart of Christ. As Pope Francis once said, "Mary is the Mother who helps us to grow, to face life, and to be free. She is a mother, and she will never abandon us."

Third Sunday of the Resurrection: Appearance to the Disciples of Emmaus

Book of Job 42, 1-6,12

Then Job answered the LORD: 'I know that you can do all things, and that no purpose of yours can be thwarted. "Who is this that hides counsel without knowledge?" Therefore I have uttered what I did not understand, things too wonderful for me, which I did not know. "Hear, and I will speak; I will question you, and you declare to me." I had heard of you by the hearing of the ear, but now my eye sees you; therefore I despise myself, and repent in dust and ashes.' The LORD blessed the latter days of Job more than his beginning; and he had fourteen thousand sheep, six thousand camels, a thousand yoke of oxen, and a thousand donkeys .

Second Letter to Timothy 2,8-13

Remember Jesus Christ, raised from the dead, a descendant of David that is my gospel, for which I suffer hardship, even to the point of being chained like a criminal. But the word of God is not chained. Therefore I endure everything for the sake of the elect, so that they may also obtain the salvation that is in Christ Jesus, with eternal glory. The saying is sure: If we have died with him, we will also live with him; if we endure, we will also reign with him; if we deny him, he will also deny us; if we are faithless, he remains faithful for he cannot deny himself .

Holy Gospel of Jesus Christ according to Saint Luke 24, 13-35

Now on that same day two of them were going to a village called Emmaus, about seven miles from Jerusalem, and talking with each other about all these things that had happened. While they were talking and discussing, Jesus himself came near and went with them, but their eyes were kept from recognizing him. And he said to them, 'What are you discussing with each other while you walk along?' They stood still, looking sad. Then one of them, whose name was Cleopas, answered him, 'Are you the only stranger in Jerusalem who does not know the things that have taken place there in these days?' He asked them, 'What things?' They replied, 'The things about Jesus of Nazareth, who was a prophet mighty in deed and word before God and all the people, and how our chief priests and leaders handed him over to be condemned to death and crucified him. But we had hoped that he was the one to redeem Israel. Yes, and besides all this, it is now the third day since these things took place. Moreover, some women of our group astounded us. They were at the tomb early this morning, and when they did not find his body there, they came back and told us that they had indeed seen a vision of angels who said that he was alive. Some of those who were with us went to the tomb and found it just as the women had said; but they did not see him.' Then he said to them, 'Oh, how foolish you are, and how slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have declared! Was it not necessary that the Messiah should suffer these things and then enter into his glory?' Then beginning with Moses and all the prophets, he interpreted to them the things about himself in all the scriptures. As they came near the village to which they were going, he walked ahead as if he were going on. But they urged him strongly, saying, 'Stay with us, because it is almost evening and the day is now nearly over.' So he went in to stay with them. When he was at the table with them, he took bread, blessed and broke it, and gave it to them. Then their eyes were opened, and they recognized him; and he vanished from their sight. They said to each other, 'Were not our hearts burning within us while he was talking to us on the road, while he was opening the scriptures to us?' That same hour they got up and returned to Jerusalem; and they found the eleven and their companions gathered together. They were saying, 'The Lord has risen indeed, and he has appeared to Simon!' Then they told what had happened on the road, and how he had been made known to them in the breaking of the bread.

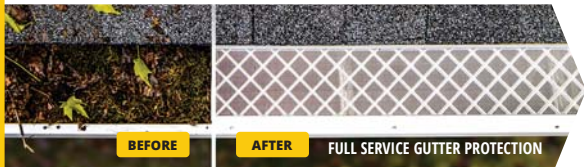
