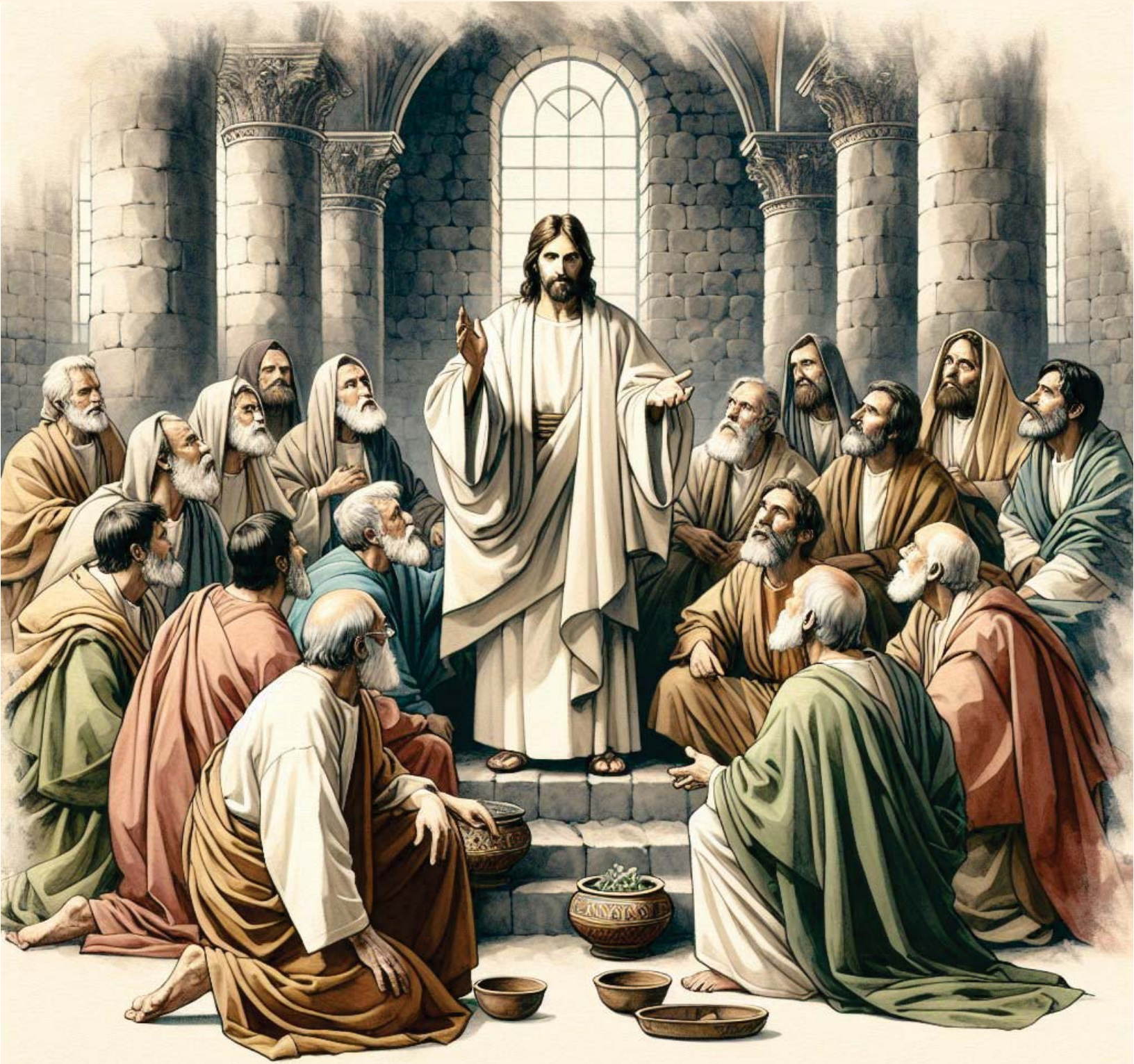

PASTOR'S CORNER

"These are the Names of the Twelve Apostles..."
(Matthew 10:2)

Dear Parishioners,

In this Sunday's Gospel, we hear how Jesus calls His twelve apostles by name. He chooses them—not by accident or status—but with intention, love, and a divine mission. This list of names is not merely a historical record; it is a spiritual reminder that God also calls each of us, personally, by name.

In the Bible, names are never meaningless. A name often carries a mission. Abram becomes Abraham—"father of many nations." Sarai becomes Sarah—"princess and mother of nations." Simon becomes Peter—"the rock" and Saul becomes Paul "Small", "humble", or "little one". Each transformation marks a new identity and a divine calling.

As Pope Benedict XVI beautifully said: "To be called by name is a sign of the personal relationship that God has with each one of us. It is a call to love and mission."

The Apostles were ordinary people—fishermen, tax collectors, and even zealots—yet Jesus entrusted them with the extraordinary mission of proclaiming the Kingdom of God. That mission did not end with them. It was passed down from generation to generation... until it reached us.

Today, we are part of that apostolic list. The Lord still calls. The Lord still sends. The Lord still empowers. Each of us received a name in baptism—often reaffirmed or deepened through a confirmation name. That "new name" is not just symbolic; it marks our new birth in Christ and our new mission in the Church.

As Pope Francis reminds us: "Every Christian is a missionary to the extent that he or she has encountered the love of God in Christ Jesus."

And as Saint Teresa of Avila wrote: "Christ has no body now but yours... Yours are the hands with which He blesses all the world."

So when we hear the names of the Apostles, let us not stop there. Listen more closely—you may hear your own name being called. Because Christ is still calling. The question is: are we listening? Are we ready to go?

May we answer Him with trust and courage, knowing that the One who calls us also gives us the grace to live the mission.



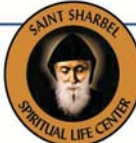

CITY OF LAWRENCE ROADWAY RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

Project Description:

The City of Lawrence and the Massachusetts Department of Transportation Highway Division are reconfiguring and making roadway improvements along approximately 3,300' of Amesbury Street and 1,050' of Lawrence Street.

The proposed improvements include conversion of Amesbury Street from one way travel to two way, construction of a single lane roundabout at the intersection on Amesbury Street and Lawrence Street. Traffic signal reconstruction, bike lanes, sidewalk reconstruction, ADA complainant ramps, pavement resurfacing, pavement markings and minor drainage improvements.

The construction schedule keeps changing. What we know right now is sidewalk reconstruction along Saint Anthony's Church will not take place until late September / October 2025 or 2026. We have had several meetings with the City, State and Design Consultant. All are well aware of our annual Mahrajan and are graciously working with us to minimize impacts.

What does this mean in the near future for Saint Anthony's Church?

Lawrence Street in front of the church will remain one way traffic.

A roundabout (rotary) will be installed at the intersection of Lawrence, Amesbury and Chestnut Streets.

Amesbury Street will be two way traffic.

Lawrence Street after the roundabout will remain two way traffic.

For those exiting the church parking lot and the rectory parking lot on to Amesbury Street you will be able to take a right and go around the roundabout or go left. Must look left first before exiting.

For those exiting the church parking lot on to Lawrence Street you will continue taking a left.

For those exiting the church parking lot on to Lebanon Street you will continue taking a left as it will remain a one way street.

For those coming along Amesbury Street in front of Breen Funeral Home to church there will be a "Stop" sign at Lebanon Street at the intersection of Amesbury. No traffic lights. You will be able to go, straight and enter church from Lebanon Street or go left and enter church from Amesbury Street.

The City of Lawrence is requesting a temporary construction easement (TCE) from 10' to 15' from our property line (approx. 6,361sf).

There will be two Permanent Utility Easements (PUE) 24sf and 32sf for light poles. Located in front of the rectory parking area.

Saint Anthony's Church will be compensated at the fair market value for the TCE and PUE's. TCE will be restored to pre-existing conditions once completed.

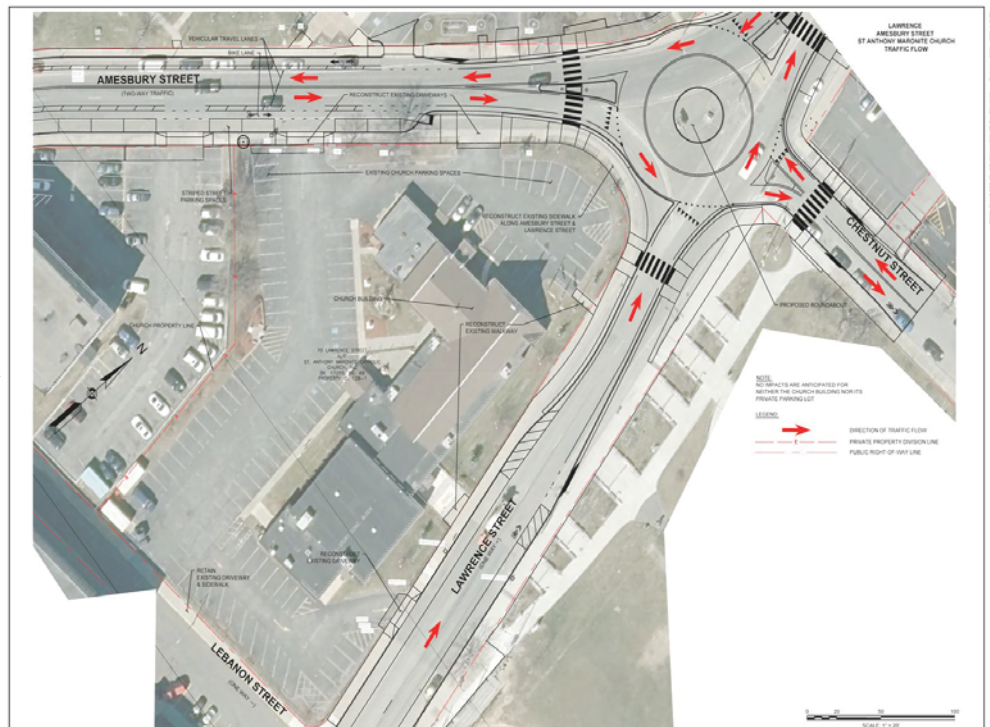
Conclusion

The above is our initial communication on this significant project. As we get more information and are told the commissioning dates of Amesbury Street and the new rotary, further communication will be shared. It is our goal to inform you as far in advance as possible. Please keep in mind unknown issues arise during construction which could alter plans and timelines. There will be impacts entering and exiting our church for a period of time during sidewalk reconstruction. We will do our best to keep our parishioners informed.

Fifth Sunday of Pentecost: Call of the Apostles

Book of Exodus 1:1-7

These are the names of the sons of Israel who came to Egypt with Jacob, each with his household: Reuben, Simeon, Levi, and Judah, Issachar, Zebulun, and Benjamin, Dan and Naphtali, Gad and Asher. The total number of people born to Jacob was seventy. Joseph was already in Egypt. Then Joseph died, and all his brothers, and that whole generation. But the Israelites were fruitful and prolific; they multiplied and grew exceedingly strong, so that the land was filled with them.

Letter to the Philippians 3:7-14

Yet whatever gains I had, these I have come to regard as loss because of Christ. More than that, I regard everything as loss because of the surpassing value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have suffered the loss of all things, and I regard them as rubbish, in order that I may gain Christ and be found in him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but one that comes through faith in Christ, the righteousness from God based on faith. I want to know Christ and the power of his resurrection and the sharing of his sufferings by becoming like him in his death, if somehow I may attain the resurrection from the dead. Not that I have already obtained this or have already reached the goal; but I press on to make it my own, because Christ Jesus has made me his own. Beloved, I do not consider that I have made it my own; but this one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead, I press on towards the goal for the prize of the heavenly call of God in Christ Jesus.

Holy Gospel of Jesus Christ according to Saint Matthew 10:1-7

Then Jesus summoned his twelve disciples and gave them authority over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to cure every disease and every sickness. These are the names of the twelve apostles: first, Simon, also known as Peter, and his brother Andrew; James son of Zebedee, and his brother John; Philip and Bartholomew; Thomas and Matthew the tax-collector; James son of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus; Simon the Cananaean, and Judas Iscariot, the one who betrayed him. These twelve Jesus sent out with the following instructions: 'Go nowhere among the Gentiles, and enter no town of the Samaritans, but go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel. As you go, proclaim the good news, "The kingdom of heaven has come near."
