

"From the Mountain to the Mission: Living the Light of the Transfiguration"

Dear Parishioners,

The Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord offers a deeply relevant and practical message for every Christian striving to walk in faith, hope, and love. Though the event is dazzling and mystical, it speaks clearly to our daily struggles, sufferings, and aspirations.

First, the Transfiguration is a call to **prayer and retreat**. Jesus chose to reveal His glory on a mountain—traditionally a place of prayer and divine encounter. Before the Transfiguration, He prayed. In our busy lives, we need moments of silence and retreat to ascend our own "mountains" and reconnect with God. These moments of prayer allow us to see life from a higher perspective, beyond the immediate worries and distractions.

Second, we are invited to **recognize Christ in His glory, even when hidden in suffering**. The Transfiguration took place shortly before Jesus' Passion. By revealing His divine identity, Jesus was preparing His disciples for the scandal of the Cross. Similarly, we are often tempted to despair in trials or to lose sight of God's plan when life becomes difficult. The Transfiguration teaches us that suffering does not have the final word; it is part of the path to glory. In our own lives, moments of darkness can be transfigured by faith and trust.

Third, the voice from the cloud says: "This is my beloved Son. Listen to Him." This command is central to Christian life. Listening to Jesus means conforming our decisions, values, and behaviors to His teachings. In a noisy world full of competing voices, we are reminded to center our lives on the Word of God and the voice of Christ found in Scripture, in the Church, and in prayer.

Fourth, the experience on the mountain was brief, and Jesus led the disciples back down into the valley to continue their mission. The Transfiguration shows that **spiritual experiences are not ends in themselves**; they are given to strengthen us for the journey. After every Mass, we are sent back into the world to live out what we have seen and heard.

Brothers and sisters, the Transfiguration encourages us to see each person and situation with transfigured eyes, to recognize the presence of Christ in others and in ourselves. It calls us to live as people of hope, reflecting the light of Christ in a world often clouded by despair.

As Pope Francis said, "Let us not forget: the Transfiguration is a message of hope—for us too." (Angelus, August 6, 2023).



Eighth Sunday of Pentecost: Jesus the Servant Beloved

Book of Isaiah 61,1-4.8-10a.

The spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me, because the LORD has anointed me; he has sent me to bring good news to the oppressed, to bind up the broken-hearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and release to the prisoners; to proclaim the year of the LORD's favour, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all who mourn; to provide for those who mourn in Zion to give them a garland instead of ashes, the oil of gladness instead of mourning, the mantle of praise instead of a faint spirit. They will be called oaks of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, to display his glory. They shall build up the ancient ruins, they shall raise up the former devastations; they shall repair the ruined cities, the devastations of many generations. For I the LORD love justice, I hate robbery and wrongdoing; I will faithfully give them their recompense, and I will make an everlasting covenant with them. Their descendants shall be known among the nations, and their offspring among the peoples; all who see them shall acknowledge that they are a people whom the LORD has blessed. I will greatly rejoice in the LORD, my whole being shall exult in my God; for he has clothed me with the garments of salvation, he has covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decks himself with a garland, and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels.

Second Letter to the Corinthians 5,20-21.6,1-10.

We are ambassadors for Christ, since God is making his appeal through us; we entreat you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God. For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God. As we work together with him, we urge you also not to accept the grace of God in vain. For he says, 'At an acceptable time I have listened to you, and on a day of salvation I have helped you.' See, now is the acceptable time; see, now is the day of salvation! We are putting no obstacle in anyone's way, so that no fault may be found with our ministry, but as servants of God we have commended ourselves in every way: through great endurance, in afflictions, hardships, calamities, beatings, imprisonments, riots, labours, sleepless nights, hunger; by purity, knowledge, patience, kindness, holiness of spirit, genuine love, truthful speech, and the power of God; with the weapons of righteousness for the right hand and for the left; in honour and dishonour, in ill repute and good repute. We are treated as impostors, and yet are true; as unknown, and yet are well known; as dying, and see we are alive; as punished, and yet not killed; as sorrowful, yet always rejoicing; as poor, yet making many rich; as having nothing, and yet possessing everything.

Holy Gospel of Jesus Christ according to Saint Luke 4,14-21.

Then Jesus, filled with the power of the Spirit, returned to Galilee, and a report about him spread through all the surrounding country. He began to teach in their synagogues and was praised by everyone. When he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up, he went to the synagogue on the sabbath day, as was his custom. He stood up to read, and the scroll of the prophet Isaiah was given to him. He unrolled the scroll and found the place where it was written: 'The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to bring good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim release to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to let the oppressed go free, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favour.' And he rolled up the scroll, gave it back to the attendant, and sat down. The eyes of all in the synagogue were fixed on him. Then he began to say to them, 'Today this scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing.'


