The Faithful and Wise Servant

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday's Gospel reminds us that Christian life is not only about belief — it is about faithful stewardship. Jesus asks a piercing question: "Who then is the faithful and wise servant?" It is as if He is inviting each of us to examine the way we live our vocation — whether as priests, parents, workers, or parishioners — and to ask ourselves: am I faithful in the tasks God has entrusted to me?

To be faithful and wise are not simply moral virtues, but marks of spiritual maturity.

Faithful means to know when — when to act, when to speak, when to wait — always according to God's timing.

Wise means to know how — how to act with love, how to discern rightly, how to live in a way that reflects God's truth

The Lord calls every believer to be a servant who "gives food at the proper time," meaning one who nourishes others with kindness, encouragement, and spiritual guidance. Pope Francis teaches that "to serve is to reign", because true greatness in the Gospel is measured not by authority but by love that serves (cf. Angelus, Nov. 2014).

The danger Jesus warns against is spiritual complacency — the temptation to think, "My master is delayed." When we postpone conversion, when we let routine or self-interest dull our vigilance, we begin to forget that the Master will return. Saint John Chrysostom comments that the unfaithful servant "is condemned not because of ignorance, but because he forgot his responsibility" (Homilies on Matthew, 78). Our Lord's delay is not neglect — it is mercy, giving us time to grow in holiness and readiness.

To be "faithful and wise" means to live each day as if it were our last — not in fear, but in love. Saint Paul echoes this truth: "It is required of stewards that they be found trustworthy" (1 Corinthians 4:2). The faithful disciple knows that everything entrusted to him — family, ministry, work, and life itself — is a gift meant to be offered back to God.

The "weeping and gnashing of teeth" that Jesus mentions is not a threat but a sober reminder that our choices have eternal consequences. Heaven is not earned by effort but embraced through faithfulness. When the Lord returns, may He find us not asleep or distracted, but joyfully serving in our daily duties, vigilant in prayer, and generous in love.

My beloved brothers and sisters, always remember, faithfulness and wisdom are the only way to reach the full Christian maturity:

To be **faithful** is to live according to *God's time*; to be **wise** is to live according to *God's way*.







Book of Genesis 41: 38-44

Pharaoh said to his servants, 'Can we find anyone else like this one in whom is the spirit of God?' So Pharaoh said to Joseph, 'Since God has shown you all this, there is no one so discerning and wise as you. You shall be over my house, and all my people shall order themselves as you command; only with regard to the throne will I be greater than you.' And Pharaoh said to Joseph, 'See, I have set you over all the land of Egypt.' Removing his signet ring from his hand, Pharaoh put it on Joseph's hand; he arrayed him in garments of fine linen, and put a gold chain around his neck. He had him ride in the chariot of his second-in-command; and they cried out in front of him, 'Bow the knee!' Thus he set him over all the land of Egypt. Moreover, Pharaoh said to Joseph, 'I am Pharaoh, and without your consent no one shall lift up hand or foot in all the land of Egypt.'

First Letter to the Thessalonians 5: 1-11

Concerning the times and the seasons, brothers and sisters, you do not need to have anything written to you. For you yourselves know very well that the day of the Lord will come like a thief in the night. When they say, 'There is peace and security', then sudden destruction will come upon them, as labour pains come upon a pregnant woman, and there will be no escape! But you, beloved, are not in darkness, for that day to surprise you like a thief; for you are all children of light and children of the day; we are not of the night or of darkness. So then, let us not fall asleep as others do, but let us keep awake and be sober; for those who sleep sleep at night, and those who are drunk get drunk at night. But since we belong to the day, let us be sober, and put on the breastplate of faith and love, and for a helmet the hope of salvation. For God has destined us not for wrath but for obtaining salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ, who died for us, so that whether we are awake or asleep we may live with him. Therefore encourage one another and build up each other, as indeed you are doing.

Holy Gospel of Jesus Christ according to Saint Matthew 24: 45-51

'Who then is the faithful and wise slave, whom his master has put in charge of his household, to give the other slaves their allowance of food at the proper time? Blessed is that slave whom his master will find at work when he arrives. Truly I tell you, he will put that one in charge of all his possessions. But if that wicked slave says to himself, "My master is delayed", and he begins to beat his fellow-slaves, and eats and drinks with drunkards, the master of that slave will come on a day when he does not expect him and at an hour that he does not know. He will cut him in pieces and put him with the hypocrites, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.




