Dear Parishioners,

As we continue to live our “Year of Hope” at Saint Anthony Church, I am grateful to see our community growing—not only in faith, but also in culture, unity, and joy. This Advent season, two special initiatives are bringing new life to our parish: our Arabic Language School and our upcoming Meelad Christmas Festival.

First, I am delighted to announce the beginning of our Arabic classes for children (ages 7-15). Classes will take place every Saturday from 11:30 am to 1:00 pm, beginning November 8. Our goal is simple but meaningful—to help our children learn to read and write Arabic, the language of their ancestors and of many of our Maronite prayers. This program is a beautiful way to preserve our heritage and strengthen our connection to the faith and culture that shaped our families. I strongly encourage parents to register their children and make this commitment to their formation and identity. The open house and registration will take place Saturday, November 1, and all details can be found on the flyer and registration link.

Secondly, as we approach the joy of Christmas, we are preparing our Meelad Christmas Festival, a wonderful event filled with music, food, children’s activities, and parish spirit. This year, we hope to add a new dimension to the celebration by inviting local artists, parishioners, and vendors to share their handmade crafts, artwork, and Christmas creations. It’s an opportunity not only to showcase your talent, but also to make our festival a place of beauty, creativity, and community connection.

If you or someone you know would like to participate as a vendor, please contact the parish office. Space is limited, so we encourage early registration.

The Christmas season reminds us that the greatest gifts are the ones that bring people together. Whether through teaching a child to write their first word in Arabic, or through sharing a handmade ornament or painting that lifts the heart—each act of creativity and faith becomes a reflection of God’s love among us.

Let us continue to build a parish that learns, serves, and celebrates together united in hope, one family in Christ.

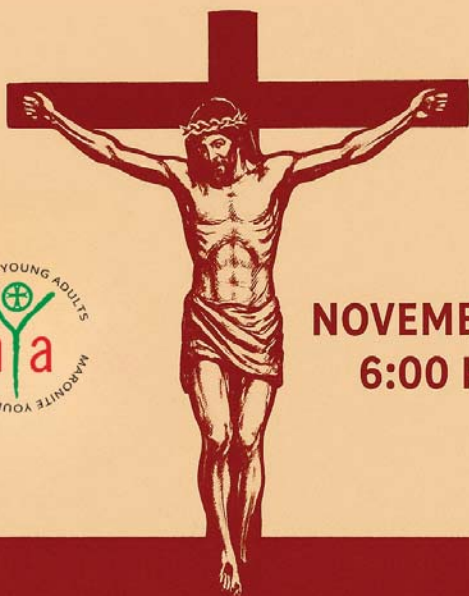
Next Meeting: THURSDAY, November 6 @ 12pm

Sunday of Christ the King

Book of Job 29: 1-3. 12-16

Job again took up his discourse and said: 'O that I were as in the months of old, as in the days when God watched over me; when his lamp shone over my head, and by his light I walked through darkness; because I delivered the poor who cried, and the orphan who had no helper. The blessing of the wretched came upon me, and I caused the widow's heart to sing for joy. I put on righteousness, and it clothed me; my justice was like a robe and a turban. I was eyes to the blind, and feet to the lame. I was a father to the needy, and I championed the cause of the stranger.

Letter to the Romans 12: 9-21

Let love be genuine; hate what is evil, hold fast to what is good; love one another with mutual affection; outdo one another in showing honour. Do not lag in zeal, be ardent in spirit, serve the Lord. Rejoice in hope, be patient in suffering, persevere in prayer. Contribute to the needs of the saints; extend hospitality to strangers. Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse them. Rejoice with those who rejoice, weep with those who weep. Live in harmony with one another; do not be haughty, but associate with the lowly; do not claim to be wiser than you are. Do not repay anyone evil for evil, but take thought for what is noble in the sight of all. If it is possible, so far as it depends on you, live peaceably with all. Beloved, never avenge yourselves, but leave room for the wrath of God; for it is written, 'Vengeance is mine, I will repay, says the Lord.' No, 'if your enemies are hungry, feed them; if they are thirsty, give them something to drink; for by doing this you will heap burning coals on their heads.' Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.

Holy Gospel of Jesus Christ according to Saint Matthew 25: 31-46

'When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, then he will sit on the throne of his glory. All the nations will be gathered before him, and he will separate people one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats, and he will put the sheep at his right hand and the goats at the left. Then the king will say to those at his right hand, "Come, you that are blessed by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world; for I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me, I was naked and you gave me clothing, I was sick and you took care of me, I was in prison and you visited me." Then the righteous will answer him, "Lord, when was it that we saw you hungry and gave you food, or thirsty and gave you something to drink? And when was it that we saw you a stranger and welcomed you, or naked and gave you clothing? And when was it that we saw you sick or in prison and visited you?" And the king will answer them, "Truly I tell you, just as you did it to one of the least of these who are members of my family, you did it to me." Then he will say to those at his left hand, "You that are accursed, depart from me into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels; for I was hungry and you gave me no food, I was thirsty and you gave me nothing to drink, I was a stranger and you did not welcome me, naked and you did not give me clothing, sick and in prison and you did not visit me." Then they also will answer, "Lord, when was it that we saw you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in prison, and did not take care of you?" Then he will answer them, "Truly I tell you, just as you did not do it to one of the least of these, you did not do it to me." And these will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life.'
