Name: Identity and Mission

Dear Parishioners,

As we meditate on the Birth of John the Baptist, one detail in the Gospel stands out with remarkable clarity: the moment when Zechariah confirms the child's name, "His name is John." This is not a mere cultural formality. It is a divine moment. The name is not chosen by Elizabeth or Zechariah, nor inherited from a family ancestor. It is given directly by God.

The name John means "God is gracious," and in this simple act of naming, we are taught something essential about life, identity, and vocation.

First, the story reveals that every human life is called by God. Before John is born, God already knows him, forms him, and assigns him a mission. This echoes the words spoken to the prophet Jeremiah: "Before I formed you in the womb, I knew you; before you were born, I consecrated you." No life is accidental. No person is forgotten. Each of us carries a divine imprint and a purpose spoken by God Himself.

Second, this moment teaches that identity is received, not invented. In a world that often encourages us to "create ourselves," Scripture gently reminds us that our truest identity is a gift. We do not have to fabricate who we are. Instead, we discover who God has already called us to be. John's identity is not shaped by popularity, culture, or personal ambition. It flows from God's grace and God's plan.

Third, the naming of John shows that vocation begins before birth. The child is born already bearing a mission—to prepare the way of the Lord, to awaken hearts, to call people back to God. His destiny is not an afterthought; it is woven into his very name. And so it is with us. We are baptized with a name, sealed with the Holy Spirit, and entrusted with a mission unique to each of our lives.

In a season where we celebrate the birth of Christ and the wonder of new beginnings, the naming of John invites us to rediscover our own God-given identity. Who has God called me to be? What mission has He placed in my hands? And how can I live more faithfully the grace spoken over my life?

Always remember, before being the child of our parents, we are the children of God, He named us, He shaped us, He sends us forth.

Birth of John the Baptist

1st book of Samuel 1,9-11.19b-22

After they had eaten and drunk at Shiloh, Hannah rose and presented herself before the LORD. Now Eli the priest was sitting on the seat beside the doorpost of the temple of the LORD. She was deeply distressed and prayed to the LORD, and wept bitterly. She made this vow: 'O LORD of hosts, if only you will look on the misery of your servant, and remember me, and not forget your servant, but will give to your servant a male child, then I will set him before you as a nazirite until the day of his death. He shall drink neither wine nor intoxicants, They rose early in the morning and worshipped before the LORD; then they went back to their house at Ramah. Elkanah knew his wife Hannah, and the LORD remembered her. In due time Hannah conceived and bore a son. She named him Samuel, for she said, 'I have asked him of the LORD.' The man Elkanah and all his household went up to offer to the LORD the yearly sacrifice, and to pay his vow. But Hannah did not go up, for she said to her husband, 'As soon as the child is weaned, I will bring him, that he may appear in the presence of the LORD, and remain there for ever; I will offer him as a nazirite for all time.'

Letter to the Galatians 4,21-31.5,1

Tell me, you who desire to be subject to the law, will you not listen to the law? For it is written that Abraham had two sons, one by a slave woman and the other by a free woman. One, the child of the slave, was born according to the flesh; the other, the child of the free woman, was born through the promise. Now this is an allegory: these women are two covenants. One woman, in fact, is Hagar, from Mount Sinai, bearing children for slavery. Now Hagar is Mount Sinai in Arabia and corresponds to the present Jerusalem, for she is in slavery with her children. But the other woman corresponds to the Jerusalem above; she is free, and she is our mother. For it is written, 'Rejoice, you childless one, you who bear no children, burst into song and shout, you who endure no birth pangs; for the children of the desolate woman are more numerous than the children of the one who is married.' Now you, my friends, are children of the promise, like Isaac. But just as at that time the child who was born according to the flesh persecuted the child who was born according to the Spirit, so it is now also. But what does the scripture say? 'Drive out the slave and her child; for the child of the slave will not share the inheritance with the child of the free woman.' So then, friends, we are children, not of the slave but of the free woman. For freedom Christ has set us free. Stand firm, therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery.

Holy Gospel of Jesus Christ according to Saint Luke 1:57-66

Now the time came for Elizabeth to give birth, and she bore a son. Her neighbours and relatives heard that the Lord had shown his great mercy to her, and they rejoiced with her. On the eighth day they came to circumcise the child, and they were going to name him Zechariah after his father. But his mother said, 'No; he is to be called John.' They said to her, 'None of your relatives has this name.' Then they began motioning to his father to find out what name he wanted to give him. He asked for a writing-tablet and wrote, 'His name is John.' And all of them were amazed. Immediately his mouth was opened and his tongue freed, and he began to speak, praising God. Fear came over all their neighbours, and all these things were talked about throughout the entire hill country of Judea. All who heard them pondered them and said, 'What then will this child become?' For, indeed, the hand of the Lord was with him.
