Annual Parish Hafli, 2026

Dear Parishioners,

As we look ahead to February, I would like to share with you our vision for this year's Annual Parish Hafli, scheduled for Saturday, February 14 (Valentine's Day)—a joyful evening that brings together several meaningful moments in our liturgical and communal life. This Hafli comes at the intersection of Valentine's Day, the days just before the holy season of Lent, and the celebration of the Feast of Saint Maron, our father and model in faith. In this sense, the Hafli is not simply an event, but a true celebration of love, family, and faith.

Over the past few years, we have noticed a gradual decline in attendance at the Hafli. At the same time, this event remains an important fundraiser for our parish and, even more, a cherished opportunity for fellowship, joy, and togetherness. After prayerful reflection and discussion, we are introducing a renewed format this year—one that is more flexible and better responds to the diverse rhythms of our parish family.

This year's Hafli will offer two options, allowing each parishioner to choose what best fits their schedule and preference.

Option 1: Dinner Only

Following the 4:00 PM Mass, we will host a relaxed parish dinner from 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM, accompanied by soft background music. This option is especially suited for families, seniors, and anyone who prefers a quieter evening of conversation and fellowship. Ticket: \$50

Option 2: Dinner & Entertainment

Doors will open at 8:00 PM, with appetizers served first, followed by the hot dish. The evening will continue with DJ entertainment, keeping the atmosphere joyful, simple, and energetic. Ticket: \$70

One of the highlights of our Hafli will be the menu—simple, yet delicious, homemade with love, and inspired by our best traditional dishes. These are the flavors many of us grew up with, prepared in the spirit of generosity and hospitality that define our parish. It is not about extravagance, but about authenticity, warmth, and sharing a meal that truly feels like home.

The evening will also include raffles and a live auction, featuring valuable and meaningful gifts. To encourage participation and strengthen parish life, we are offering a 50% discount for all active members of MYO and MYA in our parish.

Our goal is clear: to reach all segments of our parish community, to make everyone feel welcome, and to ensure that the Hafli remains a genuine moment of unity and support for our church. Gathering as a parish family to celebrate love on Valentine's Day, to honor Saint Maron's witness of faith, and to prepare spiritually for Lent, reminds us that joy, sacrifice, and communion belong together in the Christian life.

I sincerely hope this renewed format will allow more of you to join us—whether for dinner, entertainment, or both—as we celebrate love, family, and faith, and prepare our hearts together for the journey of Lent under the patronage of Saint Maron.

Second Sunday after Epiphany

Book of Jeremiah 1: 4-10

Now the word of the LORD came to me saying, 'Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, and before you were born I consecrated you; I appointed you a prophet to the nations.' Then I said, 'Ah, Lord GOD! Truly I do not know how to speak, for I am only a boy.' But the LORD said to me, 'Do not say, "I am only a boy"; for you shall go to all to whom I send you, and you shall speak whatever I command you. Do not be afraid of them, for I am with you to deliver you, says the LORD.' Then the LORD put out his hand and touched my mouth; and the LORD said to me, 'Now I have put my words in your mouth. See, today I appoint you over nations and over kingdoms, to pluck up and to pull down, to destroy and to overthrow, to build and to plant.'

Second Letter to the Corinthians 4: 5-15

For we do not proclaim ourselves; we proclaim Jesus Christ as Lord and ourselves as your slaves for Jesus' sake. For it is the God who said, 'Let light shine out of darkness', who has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ. But we have this treasure in clay jars, so that it may be made clear that this extraordinary power belongs to God and does not come from us. We are afflicted in every way, but not crushed; perplexed, but not driven to despair; persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed; always carrying in the body the death of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus may also be made visible in our bodies. For while we live, we are always being given up to death for Jesus' sake, so that the life of Jesus may be made visible in our mortal flesh. So death is at work in us, but life in you. But just as we have the same spirit of faith that is in accordance with scripture 'I believed, and so I spoke' we also believe, and so we speak, because we know that the one who raised the Lord Jesus will raise us also with Jesus, and will bring us with you into his presence. Yes, everything is for your sake, so that grace, as it extends to more and more people, may increase thanksgiving, to the glory of God.

Holy Gospel of Jesus Christ according to Saint John 1: 35-42

The next day John again was standing with two of his disciples, and as he watched Jesus walk by, he exclaimed, 'Look, here is the Lamb of God!' The two disciples heard him say this, and they followed Jesus. When Jesus turned and saw them following, he said to them, 'What are you looking for?' They said to him, 'Rabbi' (which translated means Teacher), 'where are you staying?' He said to them, 'Come and see.' They came and saw where he was staying, and they remained with him that day. It was about four o'clock in the afternoon. One of the two who heard John speak and followed him was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother. He first found his brother Simon and said to him, 'We have found the Messiah' (which is translated Anointed). He brought Simon to Jesus, who looked at him and said, 'You are Simon son of John. You are to be called Cephas' (which is translated Peter).

كَانَتْ كَلِمَةُ الرَّبِّ إِلَيَّ قَائِلًا: «قَبْلَ أَنْ أَصَوِّرَكَ فِي الْبَطْنِ عَرَفْتُكَ وَقَبْلَ أَنْ تَخْرُجَ مِنَ الرَّحِمِ قَدَسْتُكَ وَجَعَلْتُكَ نَبِيًّا لِلْأُمَمِ. «فَقُلْتُ: «أَهْ أَيُّهَا السَّيِّدُ الرَّبُّ هَاءِنْدَا لَا أَعْرِفُ أَنْ أَتَكَلَّمَ لِأَيِّ وَلَدٍ. «فَقَالَ لِي الرَّبُّ: «لَا تَقُلْ إِنِّي وَلَدٌ فَإِنَّكَ لِكُلِّ مَنْ أُرْسِلُكَ لَهُ تَذْهَبُ وَكُلُّ مَا أَمُرُكَ بِهِ تَقُولُ. لَا تَخَفْ مِنْ وُجُوهِهُمْ فَإِنِّي أَنَا مَعَكَ لِأُنْقِذَكَ»، يَقُولُ الرَّبُّ. ثُمَّ مَدَّ الرَّبُّ يَدَهُ وَلَمَسَ فَمِي وَقَالَ لِي الرَّبُّ: «هَاءِنْدَا قَدْ جَعَلْتُ كَلَامِي فِي فَمِكَ. أَنْظُرْ، إِنِّي أَقْمُتُكَ الْيَوْمَ عَلَى الْأُمَمِ وَعَلَى الْمَمَالِكِ لِتَقْلَعَ وَتُهْدِمَ وَتُهْلِكَ وَتَنْقُضَ وَتَبْنِي وَتَغْرِسَ.»

يَا إِخْوَتِي، نَحْنُ لَا نُبَشِّرُ بِنَفْسِنَا، بَلْ نُبَشِّرُ بِيَسُوعَ الْمَسِيحِ رَبًّا، وَبِنَفْسِنَا عِبِيدًا لَكُمْ مِنْ أَجْلِ يَسُوعَ؛ لِأَنَّ اللَّهَ الَّذِي قَالَ: «لِيُشْرِقَ مِنَ الظُّلُمَةِ نُورٌ!»، هُوَ الَّذِي أَشْرَقَ فِي قُلُوبِنَا، لِنَسْتَنِيرَ فَتَعْرِفَ مَجْدَ اللَّهِ الْمُتَجَلِّي فِي وَجْهِ الْمَسِيحِ. وَلَكِنَّا نَحْمِلُ هَذَا الْكَثْرَ فِي أُنِيَّةٍ مِنْ خَزَفٍ، لِيُظْهَرَ أَنَّ تِلْكَ الْقُدْرَةَ الْفَائِقَةَ هِيَ مِنَ اللَّهِ لَا مِنَّا. يُضَيِّقُ عَلَيْنَا مِنْ كُلِّ جِهَةٍ وَلَكِنَّا لَا نُسْحَقُ، نَحْتَارُ فِي أَمْرِنَا وَلَكِنَّا لَا نِيَأْسُ، نُضْطَهُدُ وَلَكِنَّا لَا نُهْمَلُ، نُبْذُ وَلَكِنَّا لَا نُهْلِكَ، وَنَحْمِلُ فِي جَسَدِنَا كُلَّ حِينٍ مَوْتَ يَسُوعَ، لِكَيْ تَظْهَرَ حَيَاةُ يَسُوعَ أَيْضًا فِي جَسَدِنَا؛ فَإِنَّا نَحْنُ الْأَحْيَاءُ نُسَلِّمُ دَوْمًا إِلَى الْمَوْتِ، مِنْ أَجْلِ يَسُوعَ، لِكَيْ تَظْهَرَ حَيَاةُ يَسُوعَ أَيْضًا فِي جَسَدِنَا الْمَائِتِ. فَالْمَوْتُ يَعْمَلُ فِيْنَا، وَالْحَيَاةُ تَعْمَلُ فِيكُمْ. وَلَكِنْ بِمَا أَنَّ لَنَا رُوحَ الْإِيمَانِ عَيْنُهُ، كَمَا هُوَ مَكْتُوبٌ: «آمَنْتُ، وَلِذَلِكَ تَكَلَّمْتُ»، فَحْنُ أَيْضًا نُؤْمِنُ، وَلِذَلِكَ نَتَكَلَّمُ. وَنَحْنُ نَعْلَمُ أَنَّ ذَلِكَ الَّذِي أَقَامَ الرَّبُّ يَسُوعَ، سَيُقِيمُنَا نَحْنُ أَيْضًا مَعَ يَسُوعَ، وَيَجْعَلُنَا وَإِيَّاكُمْ فِي حَضْرَتِهِ. فَكُلُّ شَيْءٍ هُوَ مِنْ أَجْلِكُمْ، لِكَيْ تَكْثُرَ النِّعْمَةُ، فَيَفِيضَ الشُّكْرُ فِي قُلُوبِ الْكَثِيرِينَ لِمَجْدِ اللَّهِ.
