PASTOR'S CORNER

Blessed is that slave whom his master will find at work when he arrives (Luke 12:43)

Dear Parishioners,

As we approach the Great Fast, the Maronite Church gently leads us through three Sundays of remembrance: first the Sunday of the Priests, then the Commemoration of the Faithful Departed, and finally the Sunday of the Righteous and the Just. This sacred progression is deeply meaningful. Before praying for all who have gone before us, the Church pauses to remember those entrusted with the care of souls—the priests.

This Sunday, we commemorate the priests who have died, especially those who served this parish and left a lasting imprint on our community. They were not distant figures or mere names in history. They were shepherds who walked with families through every season of life. They baptized our children, blessed marriages, heard confessions, anointed the sick, prayed with the suffering, and rejoiced in moments of grace. They laughed and cried with this community. They prayed, they built, and they served—often quietly, always faithfully.

The Gospel given to us this Sunday (Luke 12:42–48) illuminates their vocation. Jesus speaks of the faithful and prudent servant, entrusted with caring for others until the Master returns. The priest is not an owner but a steward. Everything entrusted to him—people, sacraments, parish life—belongs to the Lord. What is asked is not perfection or recognition, but faithfulness.

As we stand at the threshold of Lent, this Sunday invites us to respond in three ways: to give thanks for the gift of priesthood, to pray for the repose of the souls of our departed priests, and to support and pray for priests who continue to serve today.

May the Lord grant eternal rest to His faithful servants and say to them, *“Well done, good and faithful servant.”* May their memory remain a blessing for our parish and for the Church.

Sunday of the Priests

Book of Malachi 2: 1, 5-9

And now, priests, this commandment is for you: If you do not listen. My covenant with him was the life and peace which I gave him, and the fear he had for me, standing in awe of my name. Reliable instruction was in his mouth, no perversity was found upon his lips; He walked with me in integrity and uprightness, and turned many away from evil. For a priest's lips preserve knowledge, and instruction is to be sought from his mouth, because he is the messenger of the LORD of hosts. But you have turned aside from the way, and have caused many to stumble by your instruction; You have corrupted the covenant of Levi, says the LORD of hosts. I, therefore, have made you contemptible and base before all the people, For you do not keep my ways, but show partiality in your instruction.

First Letter to Timothy 4: 6-16

Brothers and Sisters, If you put these instructions before the brothers and sisters, you will be a good servant of Christ Jesus, nourished on the words of the faith and of the sound teaching that you have followed. Have nothing to do with profane myths and old wives' tales. Train yourself in godliness, for while physical training is of some value, godliness is valuable in every way, holding promise for both the present life and the life to come. The saying is sure and worthy of full acceptance. For to this end we toil and struggle, because we have our hope set on the living God, who is the Savior of all people, especially of those who believe. These are the things you must insist on and teach. Let no one despise your youth, but set the believers an example in speech and conduct, in love, in faith, in purity. Until I arrive, give attention to the public reading of scripture, to exhorting, to teaching. Do not neglect the gift that is in you, which was given to you through prophecy with the laying on of hands by the council of elders. Put these things into practice, devote yourself to them, so that all may see your progress. Pay close attention to yourself and to your teaching; continue in these things, for in doing this you will save both yourself and your hearers.

Holy Gospel of Jesus Christ according to Saint Luke 12: 42-48

The Lord said, 'Who then is the faithful and prudent manager whom his master will put in charge of his slaves, to give them their allowance of food at the proper time? Blessed is that slave whom his master will find at work when he arrives. Truly I tell you, he will put that one in charge of all his possessions. But if that slave says to himself, "My master is delayed in coming", and if he begins to beat the other slaves, men and women, and to eat and drink and get drunk, the master of that slave will come on a day when he does not expect him and at an hour that he does not know, and will cut him in pieces, and put him with the unfaithful. That slave who knew what his master wanted, but did not prepare himself or do what was wanted, will receive a severe beating. But one who did not know and did what deserved a beating will receive a light beating. From everyone to whom much has been given, much will be required; and from one to whom much has been entrusted, even more will be demanded.'
