PASTOR'S CORNER

Totus Tuus — I Am All Yours

In the spirit of Saint Pope John Paul II, Father Neemtallah Oneissy embraced this motto, “*Totus Tuus*”, early in his life, first as a seminarian and later as a priest. It was not chosen as a pious expression, but as a theological and existential stance: a total surrender of one’s freedom, intellect, heart, and future to Jesus Christ through Mary as the one who teaches the Church how to receive Christ fully and how to give Him completely to the world.

A defining dimension of Fr. Neemtallah’s humanity and priesthood is his remarkable capacity for empathy. Our Pastor enters into the experience of others with genuine attentiveness and respect. It is this gift that enables him to accompany people in moments of joy and, more importantly, in moments of pain, doubt, and vulnerability. His pastoral presence communicates understanding before instruction, compassion before judgment; a reflection of Christ who first looks with love before He speaks. From the outset, people recognized in Fr. Neemtallah a priest of uncommon genuineness and honesty. He reaches out with the same pastoral care to the rich and the poor, the educated and the simple, the strong and the wounded. Such universality is not strategic; it flows naturally from a heart formed in self-gift and Marian *Fiat*.

This “*Totus Tuus*” spirituality continues to bear visible fruit. Our Pastor serves as a shepherd who walks with his people. His servant leadership is marked by integrity, his preaching by depth and clarity, and his pastoral care by empathy and full presence. His fidelity to daily meditation, silence, and prayer reflected an interior discipline rooted in the conviction that priestly fruitfulness flows first from contemplation before action, integrity of heart and mind, and coherence between being and doing.

Through the guiding theme he has placed at the heart of our parish life, “*One Family, One Faith, One Mission*”, he has given concrete pastoral expression to this spirituality and to a lived deep ecclesiology. Under his leadership, our parish is experienced as a true family, united not by uniformity but by communion; grounded in one faith, faithfully celebrated and taught; and oriented toward one mission to witness Christ through service, charity, and shared responsibility. This vision reflects his deep conviction that the Church flourishes when every member feels seen, valued, and called to participate.

On the occasion of our Pastor’s 40th birthday, we give thanks to God for Fr. Neemtallah’s life and vocation. His journey reminds us that holiness is not an abstraction, but a daily choice to belong wholly to God. “*Totus Tuus*” is not merely a motto he professed; it is a truth he continues to live—through prayer, humility, service, and compassionate closeness to God’s people.

May the Blessed Virgin Mary, to whom he has entrusted his priesthood, continue to guide and protect him. May Christ, the Eternal High Priest, strengthen him in joy and fidelity. And may Saint Anthony intercede for him as he continues to serve with wisdom, empathy, humility, and love.



Book of Ezekiel 37:1-10

The hand of the LORD came upon me, and he brought me out by the spirit of the LORD and set me down in the middle of a valley; it was full of bones. He led me all round them; there were very many lying in the valley, and they were very dry. He said to me, 'Mortal, can these bones live?' I answered, 'O Lord GOD, you know.' Then he said to me, 'Prophesy to these bones, and say to them: O dry bones, hear the word of the LORD. Thus says the Lord GOD to these bones: I will cause breath to enter you, and you shall live. I will lay sinews on you, and will cause flesh to come upon you, and cover you with skin, and put breath in you, and you shall live; and you shall know that I am the LORD.' So I prophesied as I had been commanded; and as I prophesied, suddenly there was a noise, a rattling, and the bones came together, bone to its bone. I looked, and there were sinews on them, and flesh had come upon them, and skin had covered them; but there was no breath in them. Then he said to me, 'Prophesy to the breath, prophesy, mortal, and say to the breath: Thus says the Lord GOD: Come from the four winds, O breath, and breathe upon these slain, that they may live.' I prophesied as he commanded me, and the breath came into them, and they lived, and stood on their feet, a vast multitude.

First Letter to the Thessalonians 5:4-11

Brothers and Sisters, But you, beloved, are not in darkness, for that day to surprise you like a thief; for you are all children of light and children of the day; we are not of the night or of darkness. So then, let us not fall asleep as others do, but let us keep awake and be sober; for those who sleep sleep at night, and those who are drunk get drunk at night. But since we belong to the day, let us be sober, and put on the breastplate of faith and love, and for a helmet the hope of salvation. For God has destined us not for wrath but for obtaining salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ, who died for us, so that whether we are awake or asleep we may live with him. Therefore encourage one another and build up each other, as indeed you are doing.

Holy Gospel of Jesus Christ according to Saint Luke 16:19-31

There was a rich man who was dressed in purple and fine linen and who feasted sumptuously every day. And at his gate lay a poor man named Lazarus, covered with sores, who longed to satisfy his hunger with what fell from the rich man's table; even the dogs would come and lick his sores. The poor man died and was carried away by the angels to be with Abraham. The rich man also died and was buried. In Hades, where he was being tormented, he looked up and saw Abraham far away with Lazarus by his side. He called out, "Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus to dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue; for I am in agony in these flames." But Abraham said, "Child, remember that during your lifetime you received your good things, and Lazarus in like manner evil things; but now he is comforted here, and you are in agony. Besides all this, between you and us a great chasm has been fixed, so that those who might want to pass from here to you cannot do so, and no one can cross from there to us." He said, "Then, father, I beg you to send him to my father's house for I have five brothers that he may warn them, so that they will not also come into this place of torment." Abraham replied, "They have Moses and the prophets; they should listen to them." He said, "No, father Abraham; but if someone goes to them from the dead, they will repent." He said to him, "If they do not listen to Moses and the prophets, neither will they be convinced even if someone rises from the dead."

سفر حزقيال 37:1-10

وكانت على يد الرب فأخرجني بروح الرب ووضعني في وسط السهل وهو ممتدٌ عظاماً، وأمرني عليها من حولها، فإذا هي كثيرة جدًا على وجه السهل، وإذا بها يابسة جدًا. فقال لي: «يا ابن الإنسان، أترى تحيا هذه العظام؟» فقلت: «أيتها السيدة الرب، أنت تعلم». فقال لي: «تنبأ على هذه العظام وقل لها: أيتها العظام اليابسة إسمعي كلمة الرب. هكذا قال السيد الرب لهذه العظام: هاءنا دخل فيك روحًا فتحيي. أجعل عليك عصباً وأنشئ عليك لحماً وأبسط عليك جلداً وأجعل فيك روحًا فتحيي وتعلمين أي أنا الرب». فتنبأ كم أمرت. فكان صوت عند تنبؤي، وإذا بارتعاش، فتقاربت العظام كل عظم إلى عظمٍ. ونظرت فإذا بالعصب واللحم قد نشأ عليها، وبسيط عليها الجلد من فوق ولم يكن بها روح. فقال الرب لي: «تنبأ للروح، تنبأ يا ابن الإنسان وقل للروح: هكذا قال السيد الرب: هلم أيها الروح من الرياح الأربع، وهب في هؤلاء المقتولين فيحيوا». فتنبأ كما أمرني، فدخل فيهم الروح، فعاشوا وقاموا على أقدامهم جيشاً عظيماً جدًا.

رسالة القديس بولس الأولى إلى أهل تسالونيقي 4:5-11

يا إخواتي، أما أنتم، أيها الإخوة، فلستم في ظلمةٍ ليفاجئكم ذلك اليوم كالسارق. فأنتم كُلُّكم أبناء النور، وأبناء النهار؛ ولسنا أبناء الليل ولا أبناء الظلمة. إذاً فلا ننتم كسائر الناس، بل لنسهر ونصبح؛ لأنَّ الذين ينامون في الليل ينامون، والذين يسُكرون في الليل يسُكرون. أما نحن أبناء النهار، فلنصلح لايسين درع الإيمان والمحبة، وراضيَّن خُودة رجاء الخلاص. فإنَّ الله لم يجعلنا للغضب، بل لإحرار الخلاص برأينا يسوع المسيح، الذي مات من أجلنا، لنجينا معه ساهرين كُلَّا أم نائمين. فلذلك شجعوا بعضكم ببعضًا، ولِيَّن الواحد الآخر، كما أنتم فاعلُون.

إنجيل القديس لوقا 16:19-31

قال الرب يسوع: «كانَ رَجُلٌ غَنِيًّا يُلْبِسُ الْأَرْجُوَانَ وَالْكَنَّانَ النَّاعِمَ، وَيَتَّسَعُ كُلُّ يَوْمٍ بِأَفْخَرِ الْوَلَائِمِ. وَكَانَ رَجُلٌ مِسْكِينٌ أَسْمُهُ لَعَازِرٌ مَطْرُوحاً عَنْ بَاهِيَّةِ نَكْسُوَةِ الْفُرُوحِ. وَكَانَ يَشْتَهِي أَنْ يَشْبَعَ مِنَ الْفُتَّاتِ الْمُنْسَاقِطِ مِنْ مَائِدَةِ الْغَنِيِّ، عَيْرَ أَنَّ الْكِلَابَ كَانَتْ تَأْتِي فَتَلْحَسُ قُرُونَهُ. وَمَاتَ الْمِسْكِينُ فَحَمَلَتْهُ الْمَلَائِكَةُ إِلَى حِصْنِ إِبْرَاهِيمِ. ثُمَّ مَاتَ الْغَنِيُّ وَدُفِنَ. وَرَفَعَ الْغَنِيُّ عَيْنِيهِ، وَهُوَ فِي الْجَحِيمِ يُقَاسِيِ الْعَذَابِ، فَرَأَى إِبْرَاهِيمَ مِنْ بَعِيدٍ، وَلَعَازِرَ فِي حِصْنِهِ. فَنَادَى وَقَالَ: يَا أَبَتِ إِبْرَاهِيمِ، إِرْحَمْنِي وَأَرْسِلْ لَعَازِرَ لِيَلِيَّ طَرَفَ إِصْبَعِهِ بِمَاءٍ وَبِرِّدٍ لِسَانِي، لَأَنِّي مُتَوَجِّعٌ فِي هَذَا الَّهَمَّ. فَقَالَ إِبْرَاهِيمُ: يَا أَبِّي، تَذَكَّرُ أَنَّكَ نَلْتَ خَيْرَاتِكَ فِي حَيَاتِكَ، وَلَعَازِرُ نَالَ الْبَلَائِيَا. وَالآنَ هُوَ يَتَعَزَّزِي هُنَا، وَأَنْتَ تَتَوَجَّعُ. وَمَعَ هَذَا كُلِّهِ، فَإِنَّ بَيْنَنَا وَبَيْنَكُمْ هُوَّةً عَظِيمَةً ثَابِتَةً، حَتَّى إِنَّ الَّذِينَ يُرِيدُونَ أَنْ يَجْتَازُوا مِنْ هُنَا إِلَيْكُمْ لَا يَسْتَطِيُّونَ، وَلَا مِنْ هُنَالِكَ أَنْ يَعْبُرُوا إِلَيْنَا. فَقَالَ الْغَنِيُّ: أَسْأَلُكَ إِذَا، يَا أَبَتِ، أَنْ تُرْسِلَ لَعَازِرَ إِلَى بَيْتِ أَبِّي، فَإِنَّ لِي خَمْسَةً إِخْوَةً، كَيْ لَا يَأْتُوا هُمْ أَيْضًا إِلَى مَكَانِ الْعَذَابِ هَذَا. فَقَالَ إِبْرَاهِيمُ: عِنْدَهُمْ مُوسَى وَالْأَنْبِيَاءُ، فَلَيُسْمَعُوا لَهُمْ. فَقَالَ: لَا، يَا أَبَتِ إِبْرَاهِيمُ، وَلِكِنْ إِذَا مَضَى إِلَيْهِمْ وَاحِدٌ مِنَ الْأَمْوَاتِ يَتُّبُونَ. فَقَالَ لَهُ إِبْرَاهِيمُ: إِنْ كَانُوا لَا يَسْمَعُونَ لِمُوسَى وَالْأَنْبِيَاءِ، فَإِنَّهُمْ، وَلَوْ قَامَ وَاحِدٌ مِنَ الْأَمْوَاتِ، لَنْ يَقْتَنِعُوا!».
