PASTOR'S CORNER

Do Our Hearts Still Burn?

Dear Parishioners,

The Gospel of the disciples of Emmaus (Luke 24:13-35) is not only a story of the Resurrection—it is a mirror of our Sunday experience at the Divine Liturgy.

Every Sunday, we gather just like those two disciples on the road. We come with our burdens, our distractions, our routines. Sometimes we come out of habit, sometimes out of obligation, and sometimes without even realizing why we are here. But this Gospel challenges us with a deeper question: *Why do we come to the Eucharist?*

The journey of Emmaus reveals the structure of every Mass. First, Jesus walks with them and opens the Scriptures—the Liturgy of the Word. Their hearts begin to burn within them. Then, at the table, “He took bread, blessed it, broke it, and gave it to them”—the Eucharist. And finally, their eyes are opened. This is exactly what happens every Sunday.

But do our hearts burn within us when we listen to the Word of God? Or do we hear without truly listening? The Word is not simply read—it is meant to ignite something within us, to speak to our lives, to transform our way of thinking. And when we approach the altar, are we ready to recognize Him? The Eucharist is not a symbol, not a routine, not a weekly obligation. It is a real encounter with the Risen Christ. The same Jesus who walked with the disciples becomes present for us. The same Lord who broke the bread in Emmaus gives Himself to us in Holy Communion.

So we must ask ourselves honestly: *How do we receive Him?*

Do we come forward with faith, longing, and awareness? Or distracted, rushed, and indifferent?

And even more importantly: *How do we leave?*

The disciples did not remain seated after recognizing Jesus. They immediately rose and returned to Jerusalem, filled with joy and mission. An authentic encounter with Christ always changes us. It sends us back into the world with a renewed heart.

If we leave the church the same way we entered—unchanged, unmoved, untouched—then perhaps we have not fully recognized Him.

This Sunday, the Emmaus Gospel invites us to rethink everything.

Why are we here? Do we truly listen? Are we ready to see Him? Does our heart burn?

As a community, the Eucharist is the center of who we are: *one family, one faith, one mission*. It is not just a personal devotion, but a communal encounter that unites us, strengthens us, and sends us forth. Let us come this Sunday with a new awareness. Let us listen with open hearts. Let us receive with living faith. And let us leave transformed—because we have truly met the Risen Lord.

Third Sunday of the Resurrection: Appearance to the Disciples of Emmaus

Book of Job 42, 1-6,12

Then Job answered the LORD: 'I know that you can do all things, and that no purpose of yours can be thwarted. "Who is this that hides counsel without knowledge?" Therefore I have uttered what I did not understand, things too wonderful for me, which I did not know. "Hear, and I will speak; I will question you, and you declare to me." I had heard of you by the hearing of the ear, but now my eye sees you; therefore I despise myself, and repent in dust and ashes.' The LORD blessed the latter days of Job more than his beginning; and he had fourteen thousand sheep, six thousand camels, a thousand yoke of oxen, and a thousand donkeys .

From the Second Letter of Saint Paul to Timothy 2,8-13

Remember Jesus Christ, raised from the dead, a descendant of David that is my gospel, for which I suffer hardship, even to the point of being chained like a criminal. But the word of God is not chained. Therefore I endure everything for the sake of the elect, so that they may also obtain the salvation that is in Christ Jesus, with eternal glory. The saying is sure: If we have died with him, we will also live with him; if we endure, we will also reign with him; if we deny him, he will also deny us; if we are faithless, he remains faithful for he cannot deny himself .

Holy Gospel of Jesus Christ according to Saint Luke 24, 13-35

Now on that same day two of them were going to a village called Emmaus, about seven miles from Jerusalem, and talking with each other about all these things that had happened. While they were talking and discussing, Jesus himself came near and went with them, but their eyes were kept from recognizing him. And he said to them, 'What are you discussing with each other while you walk along?' They stood still, looking sad. Then one of them, whose name was Cleopas, answered him, 'Are you the only stranger in Jerusalem who does not know the things that have taken place there in these days?' He asked them, 'What things?' They replied, 'The things about Jesus of Nazareth, who was a prophet mighty in deed and word before God and all the people, and how our chief priests and leaders handed him over to be condemned to death and crucified him. But we had hoped that he was the one to redeem Israel. Yes, and besides all this, it is now the third day since these things took place. Moreover, some women of our group astounded us. They were at the tomb early this morning, and when they did not find his body there, they came back and told us that they had indeed seen a vision of angels who said that he was alive. Some of those who were with us went to the tomb and found it just as the women had said; but they did not see him.' Then he said to them, 'Oh, how foolish you are, and how slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have declared! Was it not necessary that the Messiah should suffer these things and then enter into his glory?' Then beginning with Moses and all the prophets, he interpreted to them the things about himself in all the scriptures. As they came near the village to which they were going, he walked ahead as if he were going on. But they urged him strongly, saying, 'Stay with us, because it is almost evening and the day is now nearly over.' So he went in to stay with them. When he was at the table with them, he took bread, blessed and broke it, and gave it to them. Then their eyes were opened, and they recognized him; and he vanished from their sight. They said to each other, 'Were not our hearts burning within us while he was talking to us on the road, while he was opening the scriptures to us?' That same hour they got up and returned to Jerusalem; and they found the eleven and their companions gathered together. They were saying, 'The Lord has risen indeed, and he has appeared to Simon!' Then they told what had happened on the road, and how he had been made known to them in the breaking of the bread.

اجاب أيوب الرب وقال: «قد علمت أنك قادر على كل شيء فلا يستحيل عليك مراد. من ذا الذي يخفي التدبير في غير علم؟ إني قد أخبرت من غير أن أدرك بعجائب تفوقني ولا أعلم. اسمع فأتكلم أسألك فأخبرني. كنت قد سمعتك سمع الأذن أما الآن فعيني قد رأتك فلذلك أرجع عن كلامي وأندم في التراب والرماد.» وبارك الرب آخره أيوب أكثر من أولاه. وكان له أربعة عشر ألفاً من الغنم، وستة آلاف من الإبل، وألف فدان من البقر، وألف أتان.

رسالة لوقا بولس الثانية إلى طيموتاوس 2: 8-13

يا إخوتي، وأنت يا ابني، تذكر يسوع المسيح الذي قام من بين الأموات، وهو من نسل داود، بحسب إنجيلي، الذي فيه احتمل المشقات حتى القيود كمجرم، لكن كلمة الله لا تقيد. لذلك أصبر على كل شيء من أجل المختارين، ليحصلوا هم أيضاً على الخلاص في المسيح يسوع مع المجد الأبدي. صديقة هي الكلمة: إن متنا معه نحي معه، وإن صبرنا نملك معه، وإن أنكرناه يُنكرنا، وإن كنا غير أمناء فهو يبقى أميناً، لأنه لا يقدر أن يُنكر نفسه!

إنجيل القديس لوقا 24: 13-35

في اليوم عينه، كان اثنان من التلاميذ ذاهبين إلى قرية تدعى عماوس، تبعد نحو سبعة أميال عن اورشليم. وكانا يتحادثان بكل تلك الأمور التي حدثت. وفيما هما يتحادثان ويتساءلان، إذا يسوع نفسه قد اقترب منهما، وراح يسير معهما. ولكن أعينهما أمسكت عن معرفته. أما هو فقال لهما: «ما هذا الكلام الذي تتحادثان به، وأنتما تسيران؟». «فوقفا عابسين. وأجاب أحدهما، وأسمه كليوباس، فقال له: «هل أنت وحدك غريب عن اورشليم، فلا تعلم ما حدث فيها هذه الأيام؟». فقال لهما: «وما هي؟». «فقالا له: «ما يتعلق بيسوع الناصري، الذي كان رجلاً نبياً قوياً بالقول والفعل، قدام الله والشعب كله. وكيف أسلمه أحرارنا ورؤساؤنا ليحكم عليه بالموت، وكيف صلّبوه! وكنا نحن نرجو أن يكون هو الذي سيؤدي إسرائيل. ولكن مع هذا كله، فهذا هو اليوم الثالث بعد تلك الأحداث. لكن بعض النساء من جماعتنا أدهشتنا، لأنهن ذهبن إلى القبر عند الفجر، ولم يجدن جسد يسوع، فرجعن وقلن إنهن شاهدن ملائكة ترأوا لهن وقالوا إنه حي! ومضى قوم من الذين معنا إلى القبر، فوجدوه هكذا كما قالت النساء، وأما يسوع فلم يروه». فقال لهما يسوع: «يا عديمي الفهم، وبطيئي القلب في الإيمان بكل ما تكلم به الأنبياء! أما كان يجب على المسيح أن يعانى تلك الآلام، ثم يدخل في مجده؟». «وفسر لهما ما يتعلق به في كل الكتب المقدسة، مبدءاً بموسى وجميع الأنبياء. واقتربا من القرية التي كانا ذاهبين إليها، فتظاهر يسوع بأنه ذاهب إلى مكان أبعد. فتمسكا به قائلين: «أمكث معنا، فقد حان المساء، ومال النهار». فدخل ليمكث معهما. وفيما كان متكثفاً معهما، أخذ الخبز، وبارك، وكسر، وتناولهما. فانفتحت أعينهما، وعرفاه، فإذا هو قد توارى عنهما. فقال أحدهما للآخر: «أما كان قلبنا مضطرباً فينا، حين كان يكلمنا في الطريق، ويشرح لنا الكتب؟». «وقاما في تلك الساعة عينها، ورجعا إلى اورشليم، فوجدنا الأحد عشر والذين معهم مجتمعين، وهم يقولون: «حقاً إن الرب قام، وتراءى لسمعان!». «أما هما فكانا يُخبران بما حدث في الطريق، وكيف عرفا يسوع عند كسر الخبز.

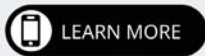

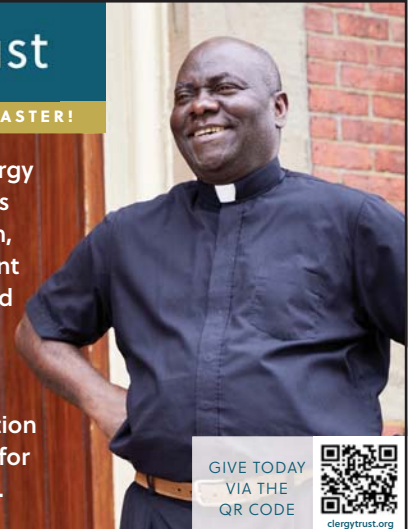
