# PASTOR'S CORNER

## A Fruitful Parish, A Shared Responsibility

Dear Parishioners,

In this Fourth Sunday after the Resurrection, we see the disciples returning to their ordinary work of fishing, yet without Christ, their efforts bear no fruit. It is only when they listen to His voice: "Cast the net on the right side", that their nets are filled beyond expectation. This miraculous catch is not simply about abundance; it is about mission. It is about recognizing that when the Risen Lord is present, our work is transformed, our efforts are blessed, and our community becomes fruitful.

But there is something even deeper in this passage. Jesus does not only fill their nets, He gathers them, feeds them, and then sends them. The abundance they receive is not meant to be kept; it is meant to be shared. The growth becomes a responsibility.

It is in this light that we reflect today on the life of our parish.

This Sunday, as we share our annual financial report - carefully prepared and reviewed by our Financial Committee and approved by the Eparchy - we also pause to recognize something deeply meaningful: the visible signs of life and growth in our community. Over the past few years, our parish has steadily grown:

- Registered families: from 1,473 in 2023 to 1,612 today
- Parishioners: from 3,146 in 2023 to 3,425 today
- Baptisms: from 29 in 2023, to 31 in 2024, and 47 in 2025

These are not just numbers. They are signs of blessing and hope. They are a reminder that God continues to bless our parish abundantly.

In a special way, we rejoice in the growing number of children and young families among us. These little ones are not only the joy of today, they are the future of our Church. Every baptism is a proclamation that Christ is alive, that faith is being passed on, and that our mission continues.

This growth, both spiritual and material, goes hand in hand. Your generosity, your commitment, and your love for the Church are what make this possible. We are doing our best to accommodate all our ministries, activities, and gatherings within our small - yet warm and vibrant - home.

At the same time, like every family, we are living in a time where the cost of maintaining our home, supporting our ministries, and serving our people continues to grow. And yet, what sustains us is not simply resources, it is the spirit of generosity that has always defined this parish. Quietly, faithfully, and often unseen, many of you continue to give, to serve, and to carry this Church forward. This is what keeps our parish alive. This is why we are all invited to remain attentive to this shared responsibility, to continue nurturing what God has entrusted to us, each according to his or her ability. Because what we are building together is not just a place, but a living community of faith for generations to come.

And as we grow, we also dream. We hope and pray that one day, God may bless us with a larger space, one that can fully embrace our expanding family and allow us to continue our mission more effectively.

Until then, we remain united in what truly defines us: One Family, One Faith, One Mission.

Thank you for your faith, your sacrifices, and your unwavering support. You are the living stones of this parish, and together, we are witnessing the Resurrection every day.

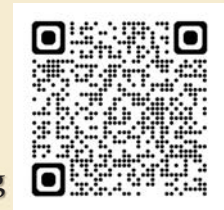

***Holy Gospel of Jesus Christ according to Saint John 21:1-14***

After these things Jesus showed himself again to the disciples by the Sea of Tiberias; and he showed himself in this way. Gathered there together were Simon Peter, Thomas called the Twin, Nathanael of Cana in Galilee, the sons of Zebedee, and two others of his disciples. Simon Peter said to them, 'I am going fishing.' They said to him, 'We will go with you.' They went out and got into the boat, but that night they caught nothing. Just after daybreak, Jesus stood on the beach; but the disciples did not know that it was Jesus. Jesus said to them, 'Children, you have no fish, have you?' They answered him, 'No.' He said to them, 'Cast the net to the right side of the boat, and you will find some.' So they cast it, and now they were not able to haul it in because there were so many fish. That disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter, 'It is the Lord!' When Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he put on some clothes, for he was naked, and jumped into the lake. But the other disciples came in the boat, dragging the net full of fish, for they were not far from the land, only about a hundred yards off. When they had gone ashore, they saw a charcoal fire there, with fish on it, and bread. Jesus said to them, 'Bring some of the fish that you have just caught.' So Simon Peter went aboard and hauled the net ashore, full of large fish, a hundred and fifty-three of them; and though there were so many, the net was not torn. Jesus said to them, 'Come and have breakfast.' Now none of the disciples dared to ask him, 'Who are you?' because they knew it was the Lord. Jesus came and took the bread and gave it to them, and did the same with the fish. This was now the third time that Jesus appeared to the disciples after he was raised from the dead.

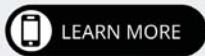
