## Blessed Are the Eyes That See

Dear Parishioners,

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus turns to His disciples and says something remarkable: "*Blessed are the eyes that see what you see!*" (Luke 10:23). He reminds them that prophets, kings, and generations of faithful people longed to witness what they were witnessing: the coming of the Messiah, the revelation of God's love, and the fulfillment of His promises.

The disciples were standing in the middle of a miracle. Yet Jesus knew how easy it is for human beings to become accustomed to blessings. What is extraordinary today can become ordinary tomorrow. What once filled us with wonder can eventually be taken for granted.

The same temptation exists in our spiritual lives.

We have access to the Holy Eucharist every week. We can hear the Word of God proclaimed in our own language. We can enter a church freely, make the sign of the cross, receive the sacraments, and gather as a family of faith. Throughout history, countless Christians dreamed of such opportunities. Many believers around the world still risk their lives simply to attend Mass or openly profess their faith.

Yet sometimes we can become so familiar with these gifts that we no longer recognize their greatness.

Jesus invites us today to recover a sense of wonder and gratitude. Every Mass is a privilege. Every confession is a gift. Every moment of prayer is an opportunity to encounter the living God. Every person sitting next to us in church is part of the family that God has entrusted to us.

Gratitude changes the way we live. A grateful heart sees blessings where others see routine. A grateful heart prays differently, serves more generously, forgives more readily, and complains less frequently. Gratitude transforms obligations into privileges and habits into encounters with God.

As our parish continues to grow, let us never lose our ability to be amazed by God's goodness. Let us thank Him for our families, our faith, our church, our ministries, our children, our elders, and the countless graces He pours upon us every day.

This week, perhaps we can ask ourselves a simple question: *What blessings have I become so accustomed to that I no longer thank God for them?*

May we never take His gifts for granted. May our eyes remain blessed because they continue to recognize His presence among us.

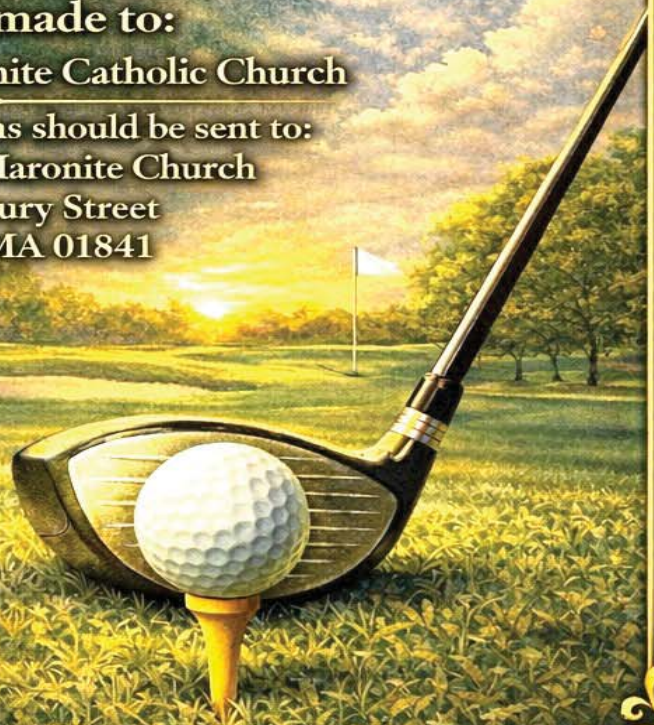

**Fourth Sunday of Pentecost*****Book of Wisdom 7:7-14***

Therefore I prayed, and prudence was given me; I pleaded and the spirit of Wisdom came to me. I preferred her to scepter and throne, And deemed riches nothing in comparison with her, nor did I liken any priceless gem to her; Because all gold, in view of her, is a bit of sand, and before her, silver is to be accounted mire. Beyond health and beauty I loved her, And I chose to have her rather than the light, because her radiance never ceases. Yet all good things together came to me with her, and countless riches at her hands; I rejoiced in them all, because Wisdom is their leader, though I had not known that she is their mother. Sincerely I learned about her, and ungrudgingly do I share—her riches I do not hide away; For she is an unfailing treasure; those who gain this treasure win the friendship of God, being commended by the gifts that come from her discipline.

***A Reading from the First Letter of Saint Paul to the Corinthians 2:11-16***

Brothers and Sisters, For what human being knows what is truly human except the human spirit that is within? So also no one comprehends what is truly God's except the Spirit of God. Now we have received not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit that is from God, so that we may understand the gifts bestowed on us by God. And we speak of these things in words not taught by human wisdom but taught by the Spirit, interpreting spiritual things to those who are spiritual. Those who are unspiritual do not receive the gifts of God's Spirit, for they are foolishness to them, and they are unable to understand them because they are discerned spiritually. Those who are spiritual discern all things, and they are themselves subject to no one else's scrutiny. 'For who has known the mind of the Lord so as to instruct him?' But we have the mind of Christ.

***Holy Gospel of Jesus Christ according to Saint Luke 10:21-24***

At that same hour Jesus rejoiced in the Holy Spirit and said, 'I thank you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have hidden these things from the wise and the intelligent and have revealed them to infants; yes, Father, for such was your gracious will. All things have been handed over to me by my Father; and no one knows who the Son is except the Father, or who the Father is except the Son and anyone to whom the Son chooses to reveal him.' Then turning to the disciples, Jesus said to them privately, 'Blessed are the eyes that see what you see! For I tell you that many prophets and kings desired to see what you see, but did not see it, and to hear what you hear, but did not hear it.'
