Called and Sent: The Father's Mission

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday, as we celebrate Father's Day, the Gospel presents us with a beautiful image of a mission entrusted by Jesus. He calls the Twelve Apostles by name, gives them authority, and sends them out to proclaim that "the kingdom of heaven has come near" (Mt 10:7).

What strikes me most in this passage is that Jesus does not send perfect men. Among the Twelve we find fishermen, a tax collector, men of different personalities and backgrounds, and even Judas, who would later betray Him. Yet Jesus calls them, trusts them, and entrusts them with a mission.

In many ways, this is also the story of fatherhood.

A father is not called because he is perfect. He is called because he is willing to love, serve, guide, and sacrifice. Just as the Apostles were sent to bring hope and healing, fathers are sent into the heart of their families to be signs of God's presence. Their mission is not simply to provide food, shelter, or security. Their deeper mission is to help their children discover faith, values, and purpose.

The world often measures success by achievements, wealth, or status. Jesus measures greatness differently. He sends His disciples to care for souls and to bring people closer to God. Likewise, one of the greatest gifts a father can offer his family is not something that can be purchased. It is the witness of faith, integrity, kindness, and prayer.

Children may not remember every word their fathers say, but they will remember the example they set. They remember the sacrifices made quietly, the prayers offered for them, the forgiveness shown after mistakes, and the strength displayed during difficult times.

Today, we give thanks for all fathers, grandfathers, godfathers, and father figures who have embraced this sacred mission. We also remember with gratitude those fathers who have gone before us marked with the sign of faith. Their love continues to bear fruit in the lives they touched.

To all fathers: never underestimate the importance of your vocation. God has entrusted precious souls to your care. Like the Apostles, you have been called by name and sent with a mission. Your family does not need perfection; it needs your faithful presence, your love, and your commitment to walk with them toward Christ.

May Saint Joseph, the faithful guardian of the Holy Family, intercede for all fathers and strengthen them in their mission.

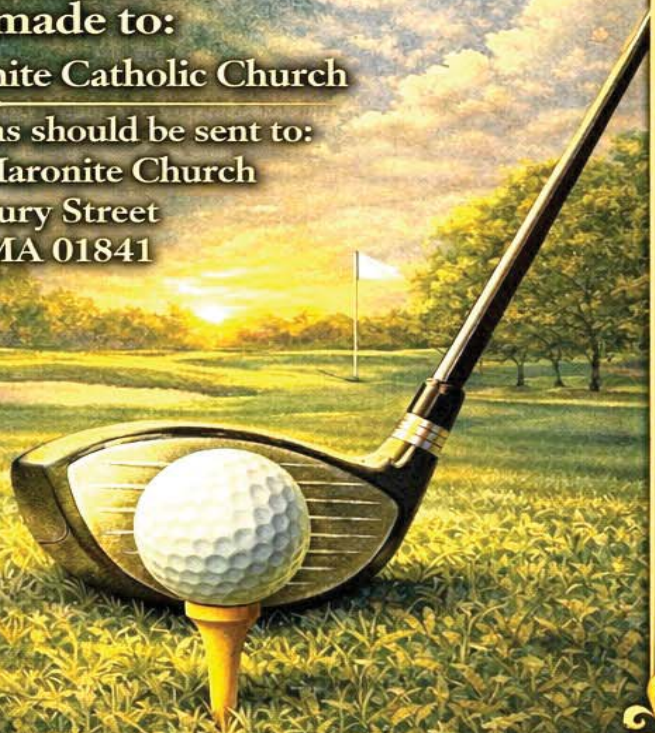

Fifth Sunday of Pentecost***Book of Exodus 1:1-7***

These are the names of the sons of Israel who came to Egypt with Jacob, each with his household: Reuben, Simeon, Levi, and Judah, Issachar, Zebulun, and Benjamin, Dan and Naphtali, Gad and Asher. The total number of people born to Jacob was seventy. Joseph was already in Egypt. Then Joseph died, and all his brothers, and that whole generation. But the Israelites were fruitful and prolific; they multiplied and grew exceedingly strong, so that the land was filled with them.

A Reading from the First Letter of Saint Paul to the Philippians 3:7-14

Brothers and Sisters, Yet whatever gains I had, these I have come to regard as loss because of Christ. More than that, I regard everything as loss because of the surpassing value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have suffered the loss of all things, and I regard them as rubbish, in order that I may gain Christ and be found in him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but one that comes through faith in Christ, the righteousness from God based on faith. I want to know Christ and the power of his resurrection and the sharing of his sufferings by becoming like him in his death, if somehow I may attain the resurrection from the dead. Not that I have already obtained this or have already reached the goal; but I press on to make it my own, because Christ Jesus has made me his own. Beloved, I do not consider that I have made it my own; but this one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead, I press on towards the goal for the prize of the heavenly call of God in Christ Jesus.

Holy Gospel of Jesus Christ according to Saint Matthew 10:1-7

Then Jesus summoned his twelve disciples and gave them authority over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to cure every disease and every sickness. These are the names of the twelve apostles: first, Simon, also known as Peter, and his brother Andrew; James son of Zebedee, and his brother John; Philip and Bartholomew; Thomas and Matthew the tax-collector; James son of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus; Simon the Cananaean, and Judas Iscariot, the one who betrayed him. These twelve Jesus sent out with the following instructions: 'Go nowhere among the Gentiles, and enter no town of the Samaritans, but go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel. As you go, proclaim the good news, "The kingdom of heaven has come near."
