All Things Work Together for Good

Dear Parishioners,

On the Feast of Saint Charbel, the Church gives us a powerful word from Saint Paul: "We know that all things work together for good for those who love God" (Rom 8:28). This verse is beautiful, but it is not always easy to believe. When life is peaceful, we can say it with confidence. But when we face suffering, sickness, disappointment, loss, confusion, or unanswered prayers, we may ask: How can all things work together for good?

Saint Charbel gives us an answer, not through many words, but through his life. He teaches us that God does not waste anything when a heart belongs to Him. Silence, prayer, sacrifice, hiddenness, suffering, and even loneliness can become holy when they are offered to God with love.

Saint Charbel lived a simple and hidden life. He did not seek attention, comfort, or success in the eyes of the world. He sought God alone. To many people, his life may have seemed small: a monk in a monastery, a hermit in silence, a priest praying, fasting, and serving. But in the hands of God, that hidden life became a light for the whole world. This is the mystery of holiness: what seems small in the eyes of the world can become great in the eyes of God.

Saint Paul does not say that all things are good. Suffering is not good. Evil is not good. Sin is not good. Death is not good. But he says that God can make all things work together for good for those who love Him. This means that God is able to transform even our wounds into grace, our tears into prayer, our waiting into trust, and our suffering into a path of holiness.

In today's Gospel, Jesus speaks about the good seed and the weeds growing together in the field. This is also our life. In every heart, in every family, in every community, there is good seed, but there are also weeds: weakness, temptation, fear, anger, discouragement, and sin. Jesus teaches us that God is patient. He sees the good seed even when the weeds are present. He knows what is growing in silence. He knows what needs healing. He knows the harvest.

Saint Charbel teaches us to trust this slow work of God. He teaches us not to panic because of the weeds, but to remain rooted in prayer. He teaches us not to run away from the Cross, but to carry it with love. He teaches us not to lose hope, because nothing can separate us from the love of Christ.

Today, as we celebrate Saint Charbel, let us ask for his intercession. May he help us believe that God is at work even when we cannot see it. May he teach us silence in a noisy world, prayer in moments of worry, patience in suffering, and trust in God's providence.

If we love God, nothing is lost. In His hands, all things can work together for good.

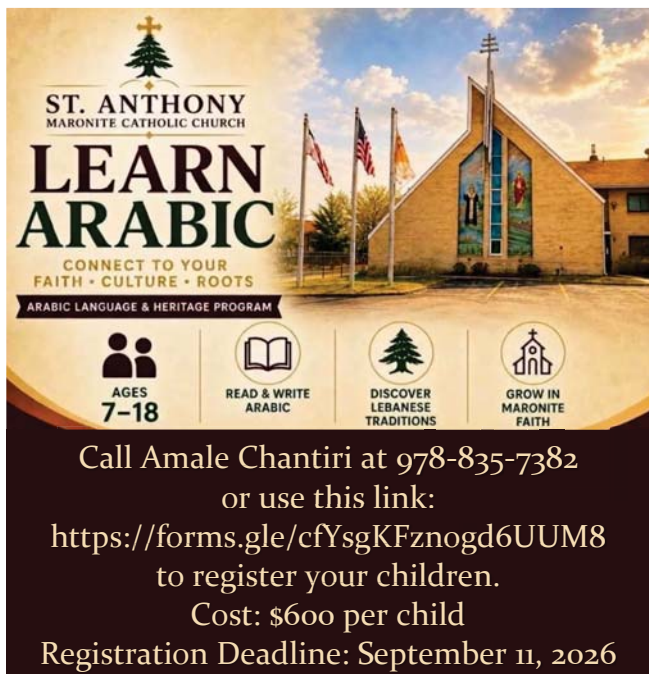

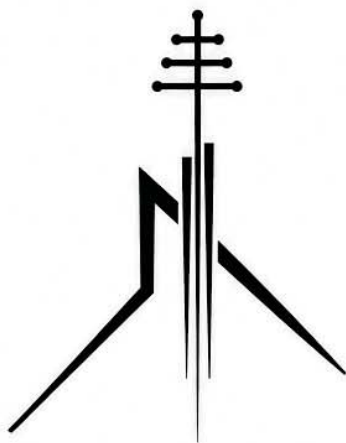

Celebration of the Feast of St. Sharbel***Book of Sirach 3:17-24***

My son, perform your tasks in meekness; then you will be loved by those whom God accepts. The greater you are, the more you must humble yourself; so you will find favor in the sight of the Lord. For great is the might of the Lord; he is glorified by the humble. Seek not what is too difficult for you, nor investigate what is beyond your power. Reflect upon what has been assigned to you, for you do not need what is hidden. Do not meddle in what is beyond your tasks, for matters too great for human understanding have been shown you. For their hasty judgment has led many astray, and wrong opinion has caused their thoughts to slip.

A Reading from the Second Letter of Saint Paul to the Romans 8:28-39

Brothers and Sisters, We know that all things work together for good for those who love God, who are called according to his purpose. For those whom he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, in order that he might be the firstborn within a large family. And those whom he predestined he also called; and those whom he called he also justified; and those whom he justified he also glorified. What then are we to say about these things? If God is for us, who is against us? He who did not withhold his own Son, but gave him up for all of us, will he not with him also give us everything else? Who will bring any charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies. Who is to condemn? It is Christ Jesus, who died, yes, who was raised, who is at the right hand of God, who indeed intercedes for us. Who will separate us from the love of Christ? Will hardship, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? As it is written, 'For your sake we are being killed all day long; we are accounted as sheep to be slaughtered.' No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor rulers, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, nor height, nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Holy Gospel of Jesus Christ according to Saint Matthew 13:36-43

Jesus left the crowds and went into the house. And his disciples approached him, saying, 'Explain to us the parable of the weeds of the field.' He answered, 'The one who sows the good seed is the Son of Man; the field is the world, and the good seed are the children of the kingdom; the weeds are the children of the evil one, and the enemy who sowed them is the devil; the harvest is the end of the age, and the reapers are angels. Just as the weeds are collected and burned up with fire, so will it be at the end of the age. The Son of Man will send his angels, and they will collect out of his kingdom all causes of sin and all evildoers, and they will throw them into the furnace of fire, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth. Then the righteous will shine like the sun in the kingdom of their Father. Let anyone with ears listen!
